## **Board Report**

- Honor Roll lunch trips were on February 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. 40 middle school students and 56 high school students attended.
- DHS continues with benchmark assessments and analysis in an effort to improve student performance on End of Course exams. Data analysis of these assessments indicates student growth and better preparation for End of Course Exams. The big impact seems to be exposure to EOC type of questions and the rigor required.
- Seniors took a field trip to the University of Kentucky on February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Next year's master schedule is a work in progress. We will realign the middle school and high school bell schedules. We are going to attempt to have common plan time based upon subject taught. Having this common plan time will allow subject level PLC meetings at least once per week.
- We've had our first District wide meeting regarding PBIS. This evidence based school-wide behavioral model will begin at DMS/DHS next year.
- Sophomores took a trip to the Campbell County Regional Vocational School and Northern Kentucky University on February 4<sup>th</sup>.
- DMS/DHS now has a school leadership team. Team members are Wes Newsome, Bonnie Sizemore,
  Barbie Lukens, Beth Fields-Hunt, Anthony Broome, Michael Martin, Julie Rubemeyer, Anna Muennich,
  and Melissa Hawkins. This team will lead the school through several transitions, including rewriting our
  student handbook, looking into grading practice changes, implementing PBIS, and many other tasks.
- Dayton Police Department participated in emergency drills with DMS/DHS on February 12<sup>th</sup>.
