### Key Findings

- **45,266 “links”** were made through the 5<sup>th</sup> month
- **150 JCPS schools** served
- **22,166 Students** have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- **6,613 students** had **2 or more needs** linked with a resource. The highest was 24 links.

### Cumulative Number of Students Served and Linked Made

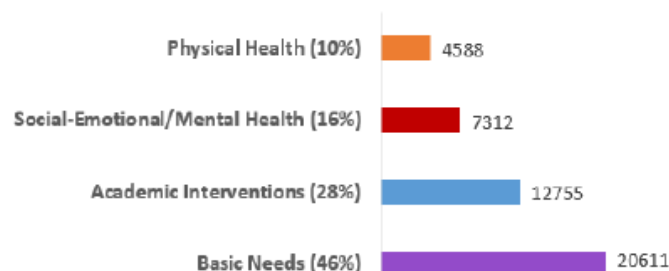

### Number of Links by Need

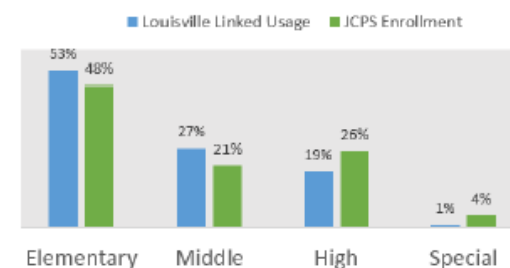


### Example of Basic Need this Month:

Family is homeless due to a house fire this weekend. They rented the home and left with only clothes on their back. They are currently put up from Red Cross but at jeopardy of being removed and given tomorrow at 11 a.m. deadline. Needing additional temporary shelter.

*Between the 4<sup>th</sup> and the 5<sup>th</sup> month there has been a 65% increase in links. Links for social-emotional/mental health category continues to increase each month.*
