

Key Findings


- 45,266 "links" were made through the 5thmonth
- 150 JCPS schools served
- 22,166 Students have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- 6,613 students had 2 or more needs linked with a resource. The highest was 24 links.




Number of Links by Need
