- 4 grading cycles for elementary and middle schools (4 report cards per year)

- Parents have access to monitor student grades on an ongoing basis using Parent Portal • Parents and schools have more time to respond to student needs prior to report cards being issued • Consistency for students, parents and schools relative to curriculum, assessments and grades
