

## JCPS STUDENT ASSIGNMENT TIMELINE FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2016-2017

MONTH	TASK
January 2015	Gather feedback about possible changes to criteria (including principals)
March 2015	Begin gathering experiences of parents
April 2015	Meet with principals to gain feedback on proposed criteria and centralized process for magnet admissions
May 2015	Submit proposed changes to magnet school/program admission process
June 2015	Submit proposed boundaries for new Norton Commons elementary school and any other proposed changes
July 2015	Revise JCPS Choices Book and Website
October 2015	Middle/High Showcase of Schools
November 2015	Elementary Showcase of Schools
January 2016	Close application period for elementary, middle, and high schools Submit 2016-17 student enrollment projections to JCBOE for approval
February 2016	Magnet school and program assignments are made; families are notified
March 2016	Elementary cluster assignments are made; families are notified
May 2016	Open transfer applications
June-August 2016	Host Mobile Online Student Registration

### Key Findings

- **52,169** links were made through the 6<sup>th</sup> month.
- **150** JCPS schools were served
- **24,445** students have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- **7,921** students had **2 or more needs** linked with a resource. The highest was 33 links.

### Cumulative Number of Students Served and Linked Made




### Community Partner of the Month:

### Number of Links by Need Type




### Example of Basic Need Link

Student has been without electricity for 4 weeks and did not want to come to school. The family was linked with neighborhood place.

*Between the 5th and the 6<sup>th</sup> month there has been a 22% increase in links for academic interventions.*
