PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- We recently had staff members attend the KYSTE conference.
- We are looking forward to the PD day on Tuesday, May 19 where teacher “experts” will present on a variety of topics.

ASSESSMENT

- The state has sent out updated baseline scores from the 2014 KPREP assessment and our 2015 Annual Measurable Objectives (AMO’s).
- Assessment materials will arrive in the district on Monday, April 13. The Building Assessment Coordinators and I will count the materials and distribute those materials to the buildings.
- Our KPREP testing window begins on Friday, May 8. We will be administering KPREP the week of Monday, May 11 – Friday, May 15.
- We are getting ready for the next round of MAP testing.

CURRICULUM/INSTRUCTION

- We just completed ELEOT walkthroughs at DMS/DHS. For the last two weeks, administrators have completed these walkthroughs to provide data to the teachers regarding areas of strength and areas of growth.
- Students just completed the Student Voice Survey.
- Principals are in the midst of completing full year observations per our Certified Evaluation Plan. The next step is completing the summative evaluations for non-tenured teachers and tenured teachers in their summative year.
- On Thursday, March 26, two teachers, one administrator, and I will be attending a Certified Evaluation Plan update session. Jenny Ray, the state PGES contact, will be leading the meeting and reviewing changes to our current CEP. In the afternoon, we will work to update our evaluation plan.
- Teachers are updating their Student Growth Goals and will soon be giving the final assessment for their student growth goal and finalizing all of their data.
