

#### **Key Findings**

- 57,945 links were made through the 7<sup>th</sup>month across 150 JCPS schools.
- 26,356 students have been linked with a resource to help meet a need.
- 8,971 students had 2 or more needs linked with a resource. 61 had 10 or more, the highest was 34.


