

**CAMPBELLVILLE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF EDUCATION AND MARION COUNTY SCHOOLS  
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

This Memorandum of Agreement serves as a collaborative agreement between Campbellsville University's School of Education and the Marion County Schools to cooperate with one another in services for ELL population through direct and indirect support to students. The agreement covers a one year agreement (January 2015-January 2016) at which time evaluation will be conducted to determine extension of the collaboration agreement.

**Campbellsville University School of Education agrees to:**

Provide services to the Marion County Schools as may be requested for instructional support to students, parents and Marion County certified staff;

Provide support to administration as they develop the programs to support ELL students in Marion County schools;

Provide mentoring services to students in the ELL program in Marion County-service by Campbellsville University students and support staff;

Provide names of qualified staff to provide additional support services to students in the ELL program;

Provide representation as may be requested for Board of Education meetings or committee meetings.

**Marion County Schools agrees to:**

Provide financial support to Campbellsville University-School of Education-in order to provide individuals services to ELL students;

Provide \$5,000 per school year to support the transportation, field support, and resources needed to work with ELL students in the school settings; Marion County has designated funds per each 6 months of service in the amount of \$2,500/ \$5,000 per school year.

Work collaboratively with School of Education faculty, and University-wide faculty as may be needed, on mutually beneficial initiatives, including design of new and/or revised educator preparation programs;

Provide representation as may be requested for advisory councils.
