Painting of Senior Parking Barriers 2015-16

Seniors will be painting parking barriers on Saturday, August 22nd from 9a.m. -6p.m. and Sunday, August 23rd from 11a.m. - 7 p.m.

In order to follow all city and district codes, please note the guidelines below that must be followed for the painted parking space.

- WATER BASED EXTERIOR LATEX PAINT (furnished by EHS) is the only type of paint that can be used. Students are required to prime the concrete barrier before painting. Primer will be supplied by EHS
- NO reflective paint
- No spray paint
- No fluorescent paint
- Students are responsible for providing supplies such as paint brushes, painter tape, rags, etc.
- The cost per parking spot is \$40, which covers the cost for the parking permit, as well as the cleaning fee for future painting. If you are not planning to paint your space, but would like to pick your personal unpainted space, you may do so for the cost of \$25.
- There are 50 parking barriers to be painted. If there are more applicants than available parking barriers, all names will be randomly drawn and placed in numerical order.
- All students who have designs approved by Friday, August 14th at 3:00 p.m will have their names placed in a lottery to determine the order for selecting their parking spot and barrier.
- Students will pay \$40 for painting/parking spot on Wednesday, August 19th AND select their parking spot. Checks should be made payable to E-town High School. Students must present a KY driver's license and valid insurance, and have a license plate number to purchase a parking spot.
- On Wednesday, August 19th, students must make their parking selection at a specified time (see "Lottery Number Selection Times") or lose their lottery selection position. A student who lose his/her lottery position, due to nonpayment or an absence, will be placed at the back of the list.
- Students must be present or have an authorized representative provide a handwritten note and student signature allowing a proxy to pick and pay for their space. Emails will not be accepted
- Students who are approved for painting a parking barrier must select a space on the parking lot diagram. This will be the student's permanent parking spot for the 2015-16 school year.
- Any artwork depicting items, symbols, or language that EHS administration deems inappropriate will not be allowed.

All designs must be completed on Senior Parking Design Request form (see attached) and returned to the front office for approval by administration. Your design should be clearly drawn and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. On your design sheet please include your first and last name, and cell phone number where you can be reached. The sooner your design is submitted, the sooner you are able to make necessary modifications and resubmit (if necessary). This will ensure there will be time to review designs and communicate with seniors any changes that need to be made.

All designs are due no later than **Friday August 14**th at **3 p.m. in the EHS front office.** Checks should be made payable to Elizabethtown High School and students may NOT pay until August 19th. Students may start dropping off design requests on Monday, August 10th in the front office. If you have any questions, please contact the front office at (270)-769-3381.
