THIS MODIFICATION, made and entered into as of the April 28th, 2015, by and between the Greater Louisville Workforce Investment Board, Inc. d/b/a/ KentuckianaWorks., 410 West Chestnut Street, Suite 200, Louisville, Kentucky 40202 ("the Board"), and the Board of Education of Jefferson County, Kentucky, 3332 Newburg Road, Louisville, Kentucky 40232, ("the Contractor") as registered with the Kentucky Secretary of State.

WITNESSETH:

Modification to Previous Agreement:

Pursuant to Part 11, "Modifications to Agreement," the parties to this Modification Agreement No. 1 mutually agree to make the following modification to the Original Agreement previously entered into by and between the Foundation and the Contractor in Contract No. 211-202-14.

The purpose of this modification is to make the following budget adjustment:

1. Replace the chart on page 25 with the following:

*	Note: All enrollments (300) must be completed by the end of the second full year of the grant period of performance (12-31-15)
Entered Employment	At least 60% of youth 18+ that were out of school at enrollment will be placed into long-term occupational skills training, post-secondary education, military or unsubsidized employment.
Employment/Education	At 3-month follow-up, at least 50% of the youth placed in
Retention	employment or education will still be at the same placement.
Recidivism	At 12-month follow-up, less than 20% of participants will have re-offended. Note: Offenses do not include status offenses.
Industry Industry-	At least 60% of participants 18+ will complete an industry
Recognized	recognized certificate/degree program. <i>Note:</i> Such credentials
Credentialing/Degree	may include but are not limited to ServSafe and Forklift

Rate	Operator. All credentials must be attained during the performance period (prior to 12-31-15).
Attainment	At least 50% of youth 17 and younger who entered the program without a HS diploma or GED will have attained a diploma or GED. <i>Note:</i> This rate will not include youth who are still active in high school or GED prep.
School Retention Rate	At least 60% of participants 17 and younger who were either in school at enrollment or returned to school after enrollment remained in school for at least one year.
Mentoring Rate	At least 60% of active participants or those in follow-up status will receive mentoring services for at least six months.
Diversion Target	At least 60% of participants enrolled as diversion candidates will have at least one case close without adjudication. <i>Note:</i> Having juvenile records sealed is an acceptable outcome to include in this measure.
Expungement Target	At least 60% of participants that needed expungement services will have at least one charge expunged.
