7.A. Student Board Representative

Discussion:

Ms. Kiefer announced that the seniors will be allowed to decorate their graduation caps this year. She also noted that AP exams will be the first and second week in May and the Little Libraries are ready to go but still need to be approved by the City.

7.B. DHS Principal's Report

Discussion:

Mr. Dodd discussed the percentage of students meeting benchmarks on the ACT. Students have improved in English, Math, and Reading this year. He also discussed the College Ready students and that this number has increased from last year as well.

For facilities, Mr. Kinmon noted that Project Cincinnati is coming May 16th to do landscaping at LES and DHS, repaint the hallways by the gym, and decorate the teacher's lounge at LES. The Dental Clinic and Student Health Clinics are going really well. The Health Clinic had 300 students sign-up.

7.F. Special Education/Early Childhood/Day Care

The Preschool playground was recently inspected and there were a few minor issues that need to be fixed but nothing that would cause harm to the children. There was a great turnout at the Preschool Information Night and we now have 35 new students wanting to join our Preschool.
