Please be aware of the following SHINE attendance and behavior policies.

Attendance Policy

Students must be registered for and attend the dates they are enrolled. No students will be permitted to attend dates for which they were not previously registered. If a student fails to attend three or more days for which they were registered, for any other reason than illness, they will forfeit their space in the Summer Enrichment Program. The parent/guardian will receive a phone call after the second missed session warning that their place will be forfeited.

Behavior Policy

All Summer Enrichment Program students are expected to follow the rules as outlined in the Ludlow Independent Schools Student Code of Conduct, as well as any site-specific rules established by the Site Coordinator. The SHINE director holds the right to suspend students who are in violation of the Student Code of Conduct. In addition, there is zero tolerance for verbal or physical threats to staff or other students. If a student verbally or physically threatens another they will immediately be removed from the program.

Parent Responsibilities

All parents with children in the program have a responsibility to see that their children are present for the weeks they are signed up for, except for reasons listed in the attendance policy. Parents are responsible to see that their children are picked up from the program on time. Parents are also responsible for the conduct of their children as well as themselves. Any student or parent not showing respect for program workers or school staff will be asked to leave the program.
