

# Summer 2015 at Lincoln Elementary

## LES Summer Reading Challenge

Every student will be provided with their very own box to decorate and fill with new and gently-used books. This "little library" will help the students participate in the summer reading challenge, which will include incentives for logging time and books read during the summer months. ## Summer Learning Experiences

Every student going into Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grades will receive a summer learning experience bag from their teachers for next year. The purpose of the activity bags is to encourage families to learn together over the summer! Items include: fun activity cards, novels to read, activity calendars, etc.

## Open Library Time

The LES library will be open every Tuesday from 5 – 7 pm and every Thursday from noon – 2 pm during the months of June and July. Students and their families will be able to use the library space to read together, take AR quizzes, check-out books, etc.

## Intermediate Summer School

Students leaving grades 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> who have failed one or more classes OR need extra work in particular subjects will be asked to attend this rigorous two week program taught by LES teachers. *June 8<sup>th</sup> through June 19<sup>th</sup>*

## "Me and My School"

Students transitioning into kindergarten will participate in this four week program focusing on teaching students social and academic skills needed to have a successful beginning to kindergarten. This program is funded through a grant by the *United Way* and will include a community partner: The Campbell County Library and a weekly parenting component.

## 21<sup>st</sup> Century Summer Program

Through our 21<sup>st</sup> Century Grant we will be offering a five week summer program for approximately 50 At-Risk LES students. A combination of academics, summer fun, and field trips will be the focus of this program.

## Primary Jumpstart Program

This program is targeted to help students get back 'into the groove' of school by working with the teachers in the grade level they will be entering. During this two week program teachers will be creatively working with students on reading and math skills.
