

APPROVAL OF STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

BACKGROUND: The District publishes a Student Code of Conduct annually to communicate behavior expectations and consequences to students and their families. The code is reviewed annually by stakeholders that include: principals, teachers, students and parents. Changes are also recommended by the Kentucky School Boards Association to reflect new / revised legal requirement as well as “best practices”. This review also ensures that the code aligns with current District policies and procedures. A copy of the code is distributed to each student during their first week of school.
