Most Important Practices and Policies that SBDM Councils can implement to ensure the greatest impact on Student Achievement

- Create and align CSIP to address student achievement, closing the achievement gaps, and standards-based instruction
- 2. Keep Student Achievement data in front of SBDM Council at every meeting (K-PREP, State Assessment Data, District Proficiency Data, Common Assessments, etc.)
- 3. Create Curriculum Policy (Ensure alignment with JCPS Curriculum Maps and State Standards)
- 4. Create Instructional Practices Policy (Ensure practices are research based and aligned to support the Danielson Domains)
- 5. Create and align the budget to support student achievement (Ensure curriculum/ instructional resources are purchased that align to state standards and best practice)
- 6. Create Staff Time Assignment Policy (Assign your strongest teachers to your most needy students)
- 7. Create Student Assignment Policy (Assign your needlest students to your strongest teachers)
- 8. Create School/Master Schedule (Ensure time and support for interventions and PLCs are built into the master schedule)
- Create Discipline/Classroom Management Policy (Ensure teachers are equipped with research-based practices to address and support Positive Behavior Intervention Supports)
- 10. Create Technology Use, Wellness, and Writing Policies
