V. Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Donna Hargens shared comments concerning *The Code of Acceptable Behavior and Discipline and the Student Bill of Rights,* the status of a request submitted to the Kentucky Department of Education concerning waiver of accountability administrative procedures and guidelines for Limited English Proficient students, Early Childhood Education enrollment, the Success Pathways school on Bashford Manor Lane, upcoming community stakeholder meetings for the *JCPS Strategic Plan: Vision 2020,* a community meeting regarding boundaries for the new elementary school at Norton Commons, and Doss High School being named a grand prize winner of the Lead2Feed World Hunger Leadership Challenge.

VI.A. Approval of Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2015–16

Superintendent Donna Hargens provided an overview of the Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2015–16. Chief Financial Officer Cordelia Hardin and John Collopy, director of Financial Planning and Management, answered Board members' questions. Each Board member had an opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback.

Mr. Brady suggested the Communications Department begin to develop a communications plan to make the case for any recommended tax increase. He requested information concerning the distribution of federal funds that pass through the state before being allocated to the district. Dr. Willner commented on expenses associated with standardized testing and requested data concerning costs incurred when the district adds standardized tests. Mrs. Duncan suggested the job descriptions for 260-day employees be changed to reflect a year-round work year.

Mr. Brady asked that Agenda Item VIII.P.3. Acceptance of Grant from Norton Healthcare for Activities and Athletics be voted on separately. He is employed by Norton Healthcare and will abstain from the vote.

Dr. Willner requested that Agenda Item VIII.R. Approval of Proposed 2015–16 Code of Acceptable Behavior and Discipline and The Student Bill of Rights be voted on separately and voiced her concern about a variety of issues concerning the Code including disproportionality, disparities in applying the Code, discrepancies in discipline policies among schools, and a lack of evidence of reduction in misbehavior.

Chief Equity Officer John Marshall and Jackie Wisman, director of Safe and Drug-Free Schools/Student Relations, came forward to answer Board members' questions. Dr. Hargens and presenters advised that the Code is reviewed by the Code of Conduct Committee every other year and the current Code was approved in June 2014. The changes under consideration this evening are not substantive in nature and are limited to updated names, titles, contact information, and verbiage relating to Board policy changes. Chair Jones asked if there is a process for reviewing published documents and putting them into consumer-friendly language so they can be easily understood.

 - Dr. Willner repeated her May 11, 2015, request concerning committee structure to include the following: is there a list of all committees, are they 50/50 or another structure, does each committee have a charter, when do committees meet, are the committees open to others, are there minutes, and what are the structures and mechanisms in place for policy recommendations to come through the committee to the Board. She also requested information regarding the process for adding standardized tests that are not state or federally mandated and if that comes to the Board for approval as well as information concerning the community-based task force recommended in the magnet school review.
