## Superintendent's Report June 8, 2015

Chair David Jones, members of the Board; it is my pleasure to call your attention to a few items of special interest.

In updating the Success Pathways Timeline:

- Possible school names have been submitted to Dr. Raisor and Dr. Rodosky.
- ECE students have had an ARC meeting and placed in the appropriate placement.
- Middle school students have been selected, parents contacted by phone, and all parents should have received a letter today.
- High school students are currently being reviewed. Students should be placed and parents notified by June 15.
- The school staffing process has begun. The committee has met and interviews will begin next week.
- Dates and topics for the Success Pathways Institute have been identified, as well as a keynote speaker.

Now an update on *Louisville Linked* — which is a systematic way to link resources and services to needs. 60,782 links were made through the 8<sup>th</sup> month serving 150 schools and 27, 932 students.

We are working with the Kentucky Science Center to draft an agreement with JCPS to operate the Challenger Center for 2015-16. The Science Center is benchmarking against successful Challenger models. This will greatly EXPAND the number of students who benefit and learn from the Center. There will be no interruption in service. Any agreement would come to the Board for approval.
