We are requesting approval for an out of town/overnight trip to FLBA students and advisor.

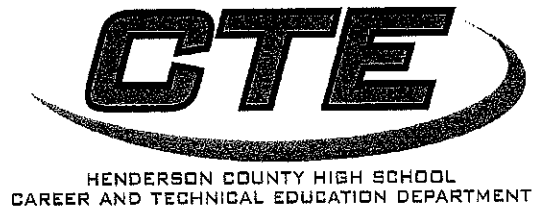
FBLA State Leadership Camp
