I am pleased to enclose a check in the amount of \$250,000 (Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand and 0/100ths), representing a grant from The C. E. and S. Foundation to Jefferson County Public Education Foundation. This grant is intended to support Year One of a three year plan to pilot the expansion of Jefferson County Public Schools Kindergarten Readiness Camps. With satisfactory implementation and reporting, the C. E. and S. Foundation expects to continue funding at this level for Years Two and Three and to collaborate with the Jefferson County Public Education to broaden the funder base for this program.

- Check-in, expected mid-July 2015 regarding enrollment numbers
- Interim report, expected August 2015 regarding pre-post EMBARK scores
- Final report, expected November 2015 regarding participating Kindergarten's Brigance scores


Our Program Officer Tony Peyton will work with you and your colleagues at Jefferson County Public Schools to help define reporting expectations.
