

CREATE A NEW POSITION, FAMILY/COMMUNITY DISTRICT EARLY CHILDHOOD COORDINATOR

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:

The FCPS early childhood department is increasingly growing to include the community in regards to promoting school readiness. The department realizes the importance of the school system to involve community, including a focus on birth to 3, in closing the achievement gap.
