- ❖ Summer Learning continues to occur at LES as we have made every effort to attack the summer learning slide that typically occurs with our students. Students have been attending the LES library during the summer hours and taking AR tests. The 21<sup>st</sup> Century Summer Program went well with students participating in numerous enrichment activities and concluded at the end of June. There are approximately 25 incoming kindergarten students participating in the "Me and My School" program. We had numerous students participate in the Little Devils Science Camp and the LES Chess Camp. The Primary Jumpstart has begun for students entering grades 1-4 with the teachers focusing on the essential math and reading skills from their previous grade level and for the upcoming school year.
- ❖ School administration will continue to look at opportunities for building leadership capacity in the current 6<sup>th</sup> grade students. All 6<sup>th</sup> graders will complete an interest survey during the first week of school to determine possible leadership roles for the current school year.
