Proposed Requirements for Students to Earn the Work Ready Seal:

The Work Ready Seal may be earned by high school students who display a superior work ethic by meeting the following minimum requirements during their senior year:

- No more than two unexcused absences.
- No more than two unexcused tardies
- No level 2 or higher discipline referrals
- Grade point average of at least 2.5 with no failures for the year
- Involvement in at least two co-curricular or extra-curricular activities, which may include part-time employment and/or community service projects of at least 25 hours (done separately from school-related functions)
- Participation in 90% of the soft skills activities during high school career*
- Successfully defend Capstone presentation

*The high school will offer 8-9 activities per year, including at least 1 from each of the following categories:

- Communication
- Agency (think, question, pursue, create)
- Collaboration
- Social Awareness & Empathy
- Critical Thinking & Problem Solving
- Takes Pride in Work Well Done
