

## ***Customized 2015-2016 Advertising Package for the Henderson County School System***

This prerecorded program looks at local, state and national education issues in depth. The show runs an average of five (5) to six (6) minutes in length and airs throughout the school year. This program is valued at \$900.00 ( \$90.00 per show during the school year, Aug-May)

Also included is sponsorship of the locally originated **Weekly School Calendar**. This prerecorded program is hosted by Cindy Williams sharing the latest school activities. The program airs during the 7:30 am edition of WSON AM & FM's award winning Henderson Report of local news each Saturday and Monday. Reports average three (3) minutes in length. This program is valued at \$4,440.00 ( \$60.00 per show during the school year)

**Total cost of this package is \$6,000.00.**
