All parents/guardians will walk in their child's shoes and report to their classroom for lots of learning!

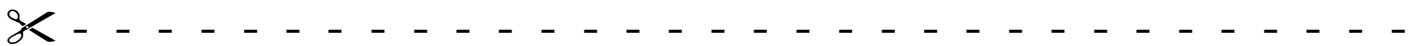
- Learn more about your child's daily schedule and class expectations.
