About AP (Advanced Placement)

- College-level courses taught in high school
- AP is a subsidiary of the College Board (AP, SAT, PSAT)
- **AP tests are developed and reviewed by nation's top colleges and secondary schools** (*Princeton, Dartmouth, Emory, Yale, University of Virginia, St. Louis University High School, Phillips Exeter Academy, and Thomas Jefferson High School*).
- Possibility of earning college-credit if students earn a qualifying score on an AP Exam (3, 4, or 5) - actual credit depends upon the course exam and university. AP Exam fees were \$91/exam in 2015.

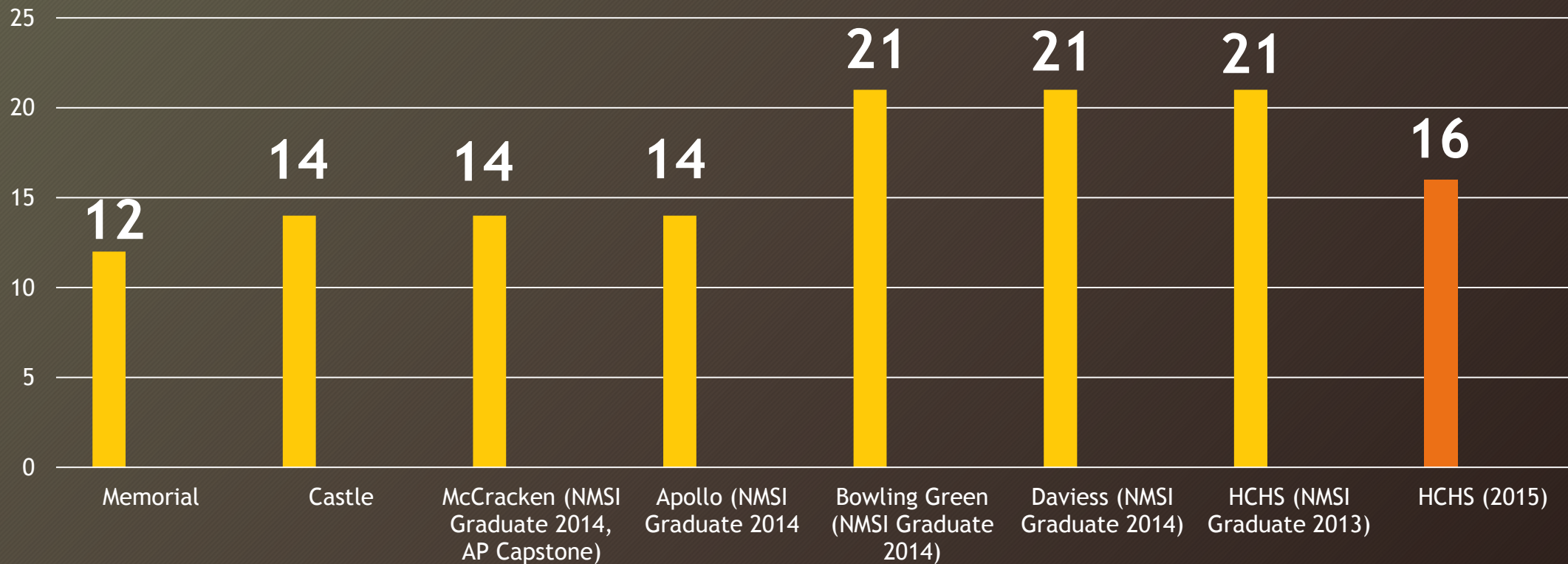

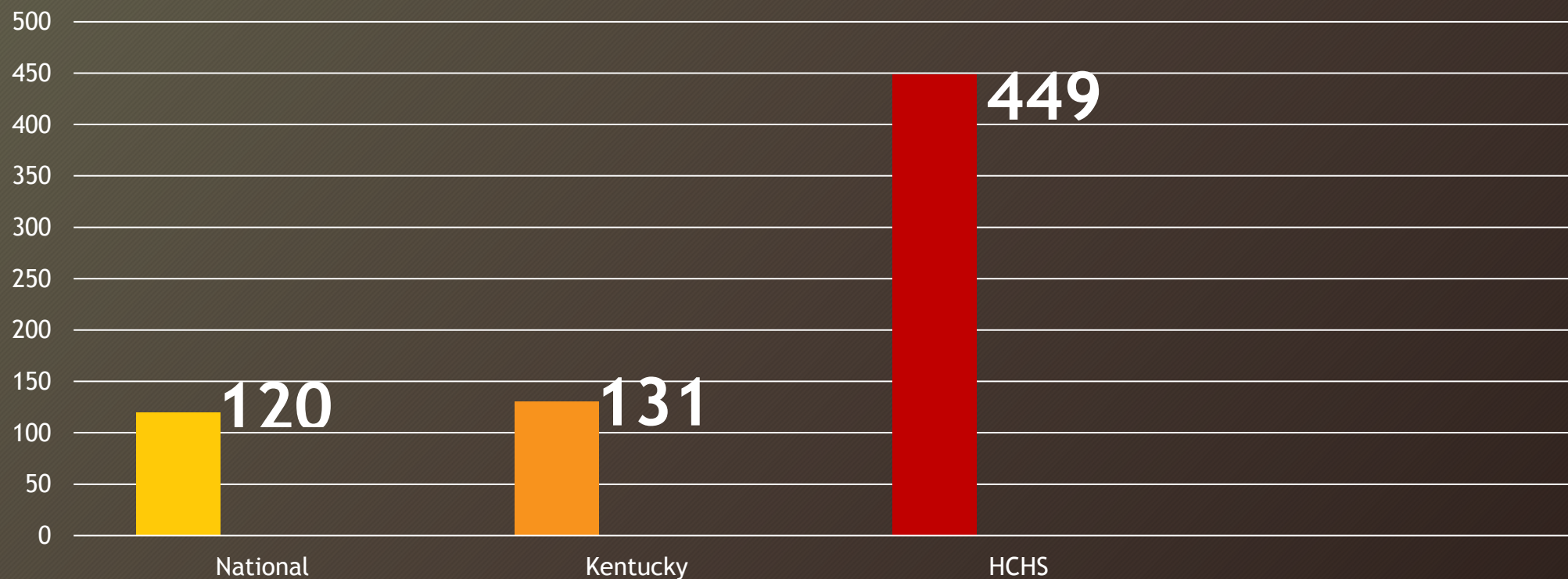

AP Courses Offered by Area High Schools

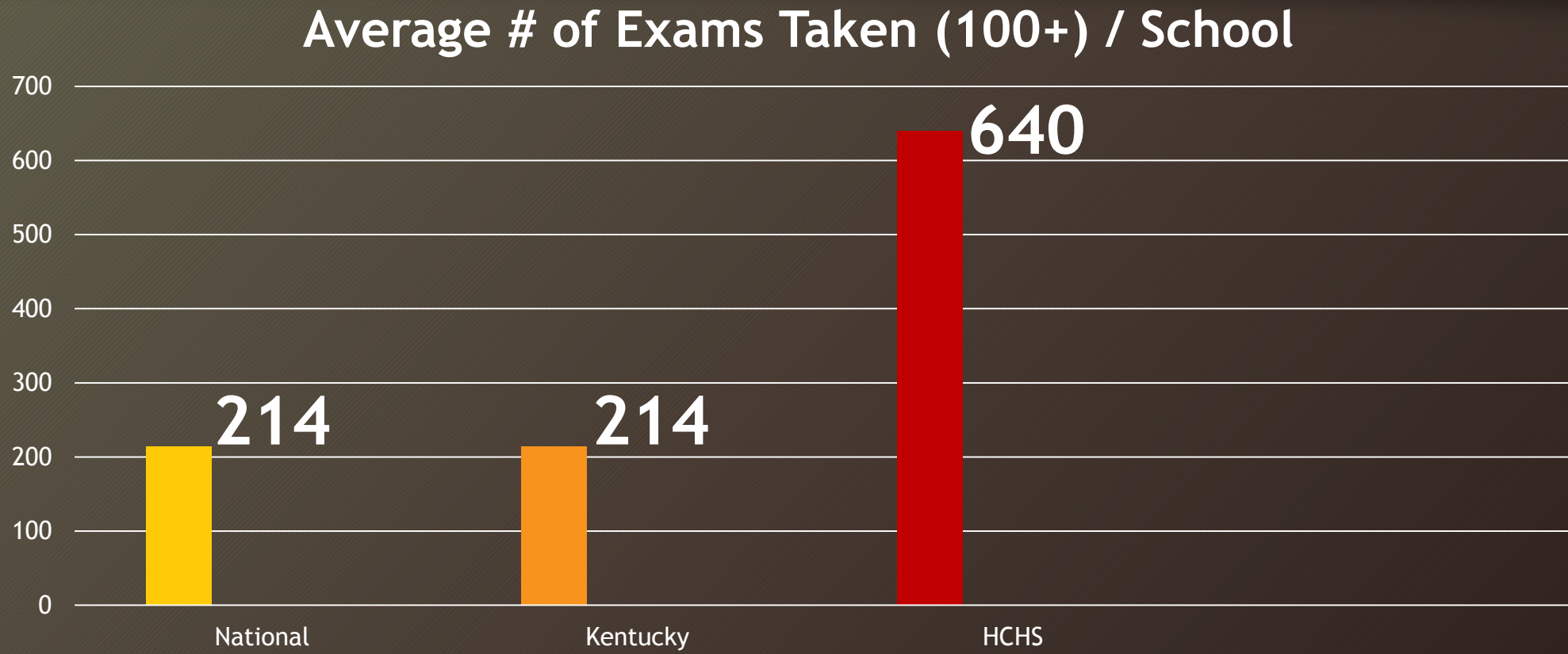


2014-15 Data Compared

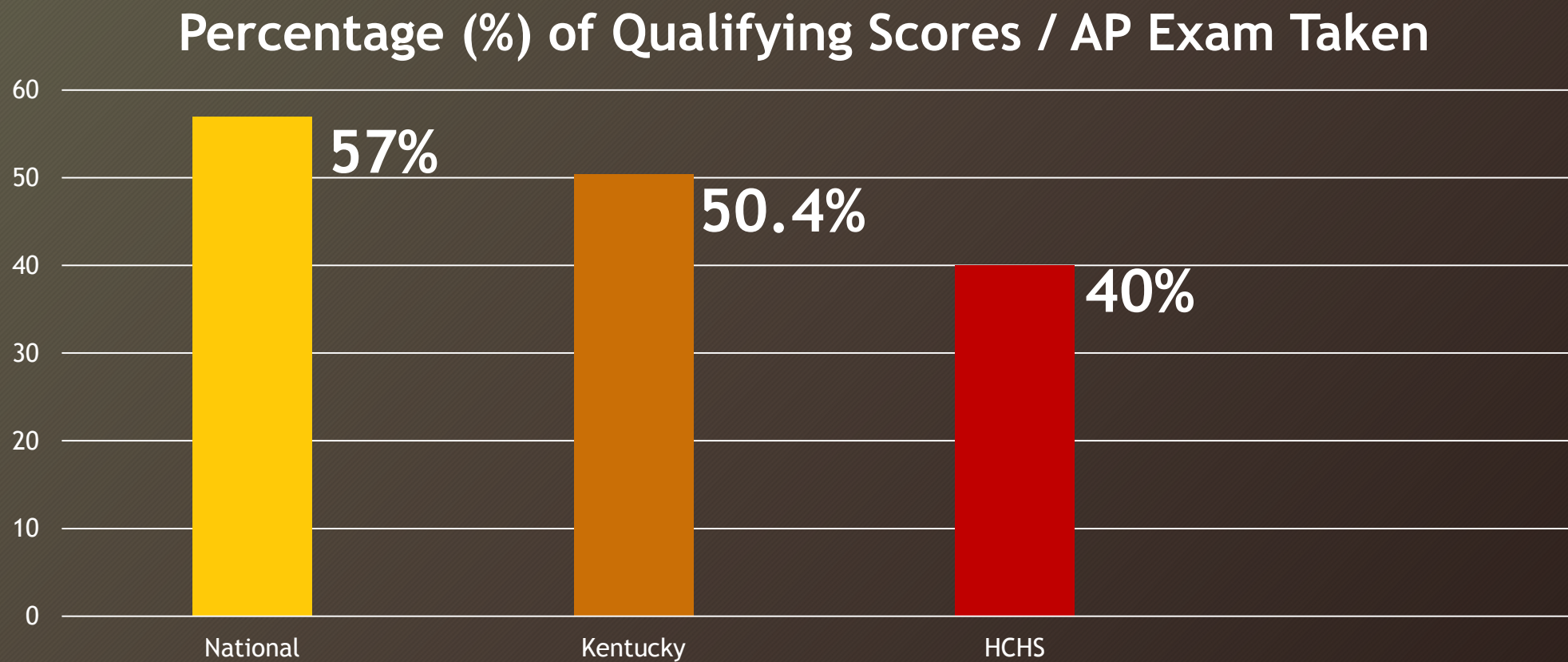
Average # Students / School Taking AP EXAMS



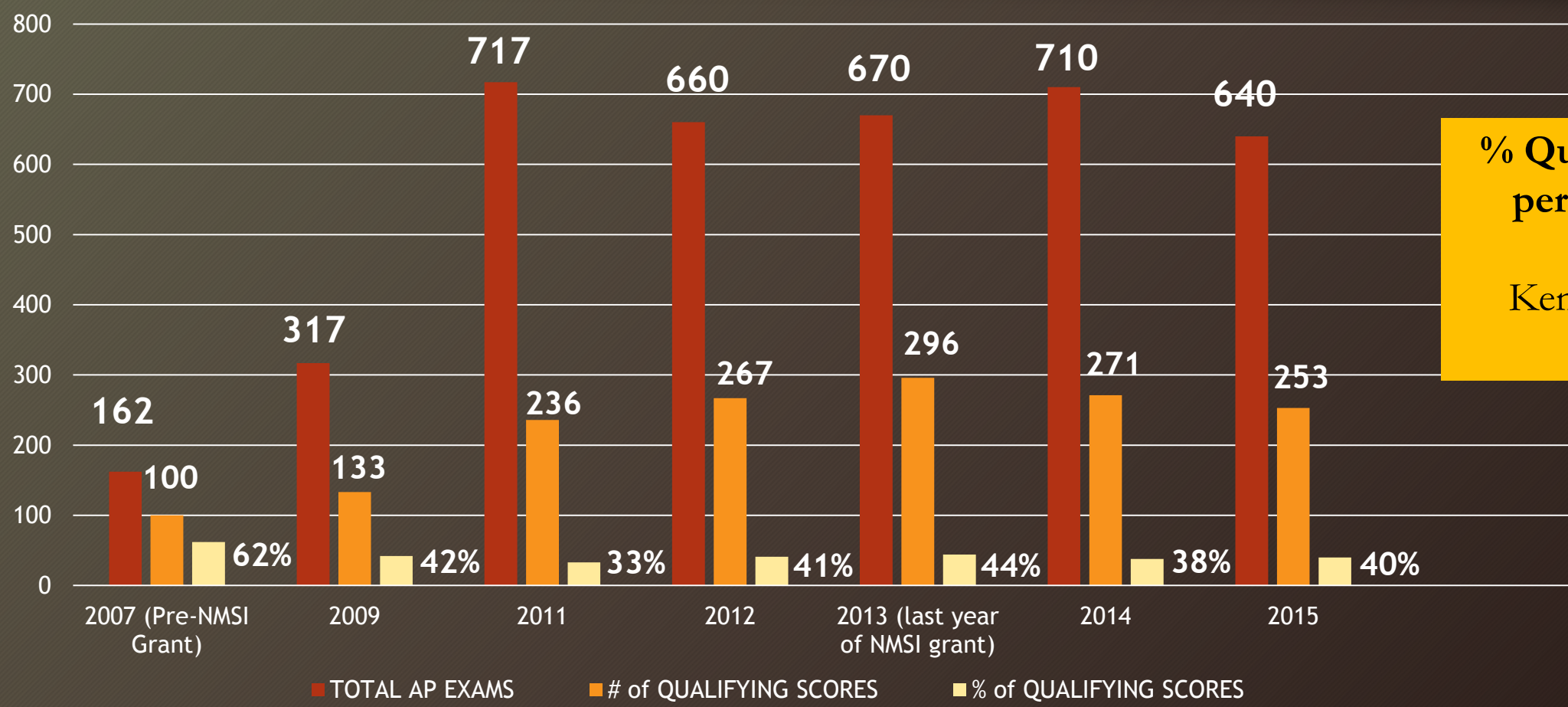
2014-15 Data Compared



2015 Data Compared



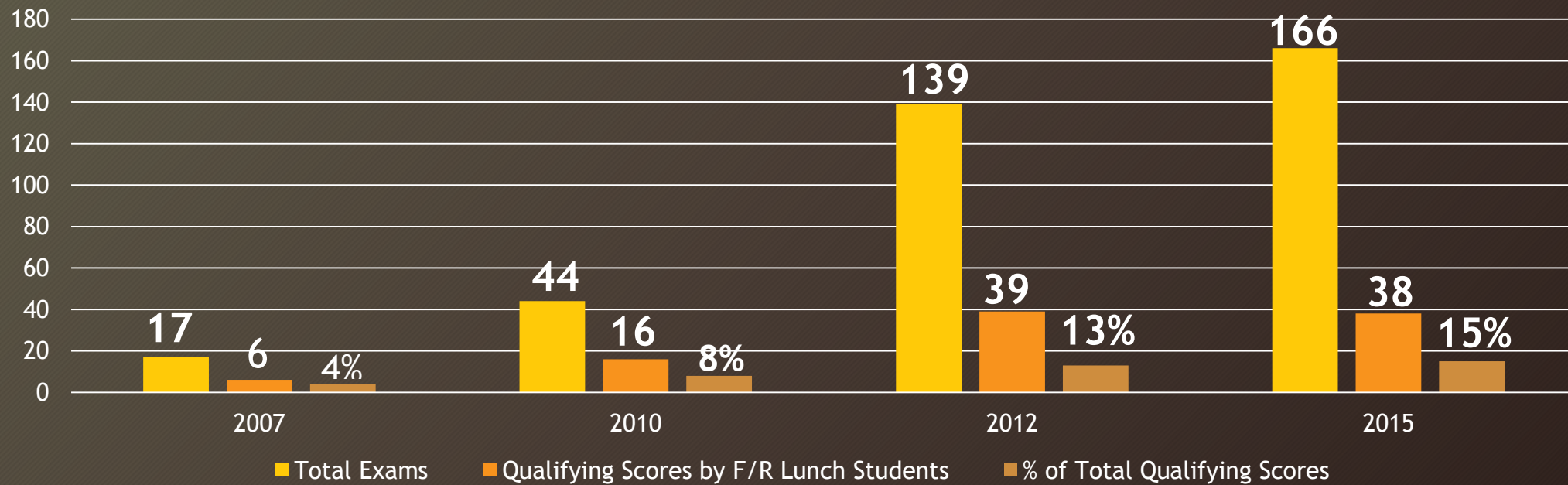
