

REQUEST FOR A SHORTENED SCHOOL DAY

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:

A shortened school day is being requested for a student with disabilities. This request represents the recommendation of a 504 Committee based on data from the current Individual Accommodation Plan and a physician's recommendation. A plan has been developed to address the student's return to a full school day. The 504 Committee will continue to address this possibility with input from the physician.

PROPOSAL:

1. A shorten school day has been recommended for a kindergarten student diagnosed with attention deficient disorder, behavior disorder, seizure disorder, persuasive developmental disorder, and asthma due to reduced strength and vitality.
2. A shorten school day has been recommended for a High School Student diagnosed with anxiety disorder, and panic disorder who experiences difficulty breathing when panic attacks occur.
3. A shorten school day has been requested for a middle school student experiencing daily pain from chronic ophthalmologic migraines and a tumor which prevents regular attendance.
