## **Office of Chief Operations Officer**

## Fiscal Manager Facilities and Transportation

**Becomes Fiscal Manager Operations** 

- This position now reports directly to the Chief Operations Officer
- Responsibilities remain the same, but creates logical reporting structure as the position manages fiscal affairs of multiple operations departments.

## **Capital Improvements and Planning**

#### **Director of Facilities and Environment Services**

Becomes the Director of Capital Improvements and Planning

- Provides direct oversight and leadership to our major Renovation and Construction initiatives, as well as long range facilities planning and prioritization of future projects. Oversees Director of Facilities Planning and Director of Mechanical Planning
- Director of Mechanical and Electronic Maintenance
  Becomes the Director of Mechanical Planning
  - Focuses on design of HVAC Renovations and Replacements, as well as Energy Savings
    Projects across the district
- Director of Facilities Planning
  - o Retains current job responsibilities

# **Safety and Environmental Services**

#### **Director of Safety and Environment Services**

**Safety and Environmental Services** becomes a stand-alone department now reporting directly to the **Chief Operations Officer**.

 All Environmental and Safety related responsibilities and personnel that were assigned to other Facilities and Environmental Services Departments become part of this department – Energy Auditing, Abatement, and Fire Extinguisher

### **Property Management and Maintenance**

**Director of Property Management and Maintenance (New Position)** Reports to Chief Operations Officer.

- Provides direct oversight and leadership for the maintenance and management of JCPS properties, including buildings, grounds, preventative maintenance, day to day repairs, and minor renovations.
- Oversees Maintenance, Grounds, Renovations, and Housekeeping Departments
  - **HVAC Maintenance** becomes part of **Maintenance**

## **Information Technology**

Business Machines department will become part of Technology Support Services **Electronics** department will now become part of **Infrastructure Services** 

Both Departments were formally part of Mechanical and Electronic Maintenance

## **Performance & Technology**

Supply Services and Materials Production will now report to the Director of Performance & Technology

## **School & Community Nutrition Services**

The Manager Nutrition Services Center will now have direct supervision and management of the Nutrition Warehouse and Food Distribution Network of trucks and drivers.

These two functions were previously part of **Supply Services** 

#### Theory of Action:

IF we align, streamline, and simplify the ways in which we provide services, THEN we will be to provide more responsive, more efficient and better services to our schools.

Additionally this new alignment creates a clear path to:

- 1. Create a single ticketing system to request operations services
- 2. Just in time delivery and reduction in warehoused assets
- 3. Zoned Maintenance Teams better aligned to quickly address needs
- 4. A nimble, agile organizational structure that can be easily adjusted and modified as needed.
