## APPROVAL OF USE OF KENTUCKY SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION (KSBA) TO FACILITATE THE LOCAL PLANNING COMMITTEE AND DISTRICT FACILITY PLANNING PROCESS

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE: Every four years each Kentucky school District must determine their facilities needs through a Local Planning Committee. The Committee meets to review building condition, instructional priorities and student population in order to recommend a District Facilities Plan to the Board. Currently, all positions on the Local Planning Committee have expired and a new process is in place for selecting members. Staff believes that in order to produce a transparent process and ensure equitable representation of stakeholder groups, a third party facilitator is necessary. The Kentucky School Boards Association has the knowledge and expertise to both facilitate the selection process, as well as to assist in the drafting of a facilities plan that will encompass all of the current and future needs of the District.
