

**APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED CHANGE ORDER (NO. TWENTY)**  
**TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE RENOVATION AT**  
**JESSIE CLARK MIDDLE SCHOOL**  
**BG 13-023**

**BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:** The renovation of the existing Jessie Clark Middle School is listed as priority 2c.11 on FCPS's 2009 District Facility Plan. Tate Hill Jacobs Architects produced final Construction Documents for bidding describing a renovation of the existing building and the construction of an addition totaling approximately 125,321 SF to serve 1,000 students, based upon FCPS middle school program standards. Bids were received on May 15, 2013 and construction began in June, 2013. The Department of Physical Support Services, the design consultants and the local building code officials have reviewed the progress of the work. Changes to the original plans and specifications have been necessary in order to satisfy the requirements described below. Approval of these changes allows the work to be completed.

**COST:** The description and cost of these items are summarized as follows:

A 5% contingency (\$902,075) is included in the project's available funds. There have been nineteen previous change orders on this project. The cost of the current and all changes orders represents a 0.68% increase in the construction cost.
