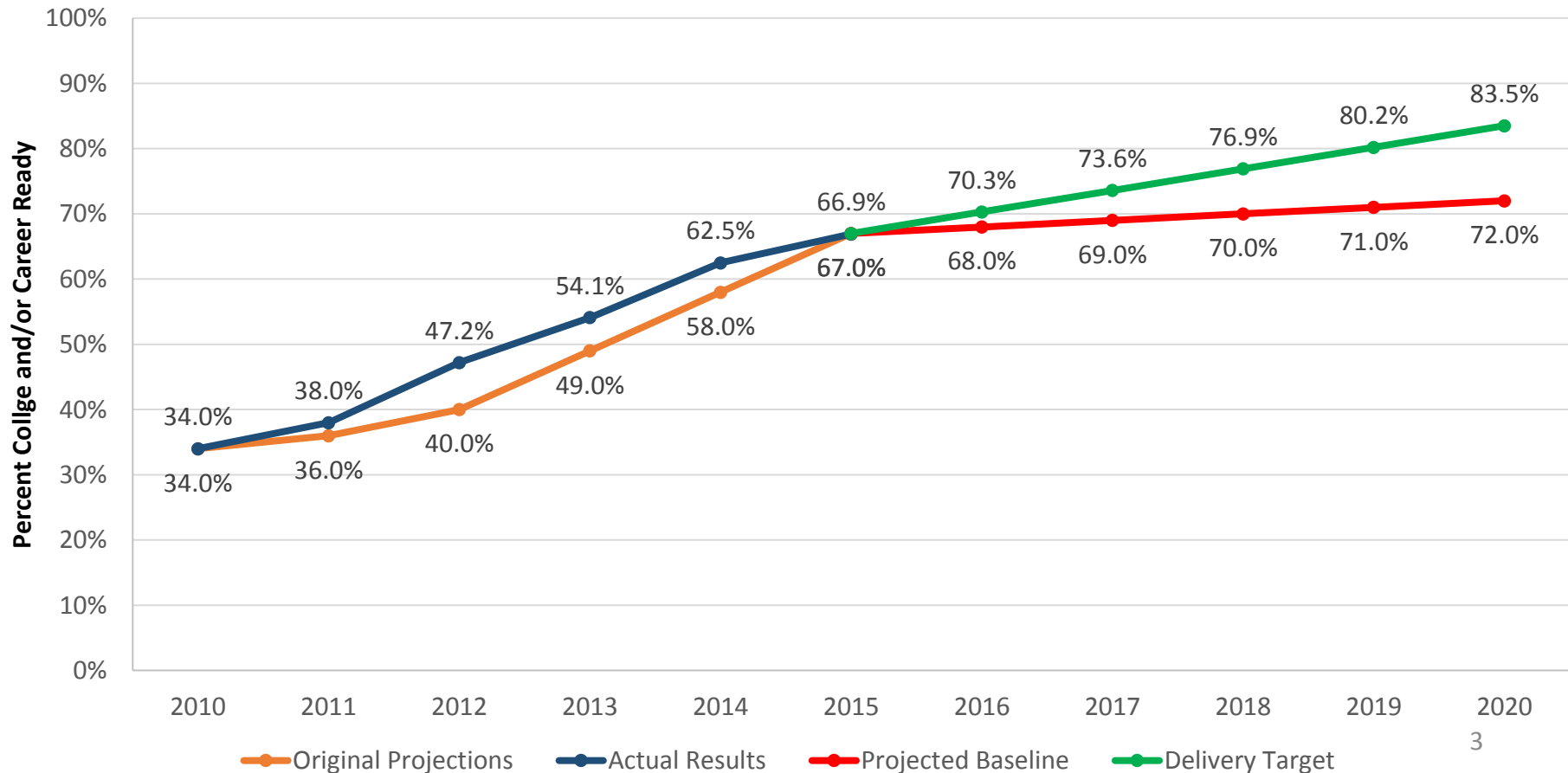

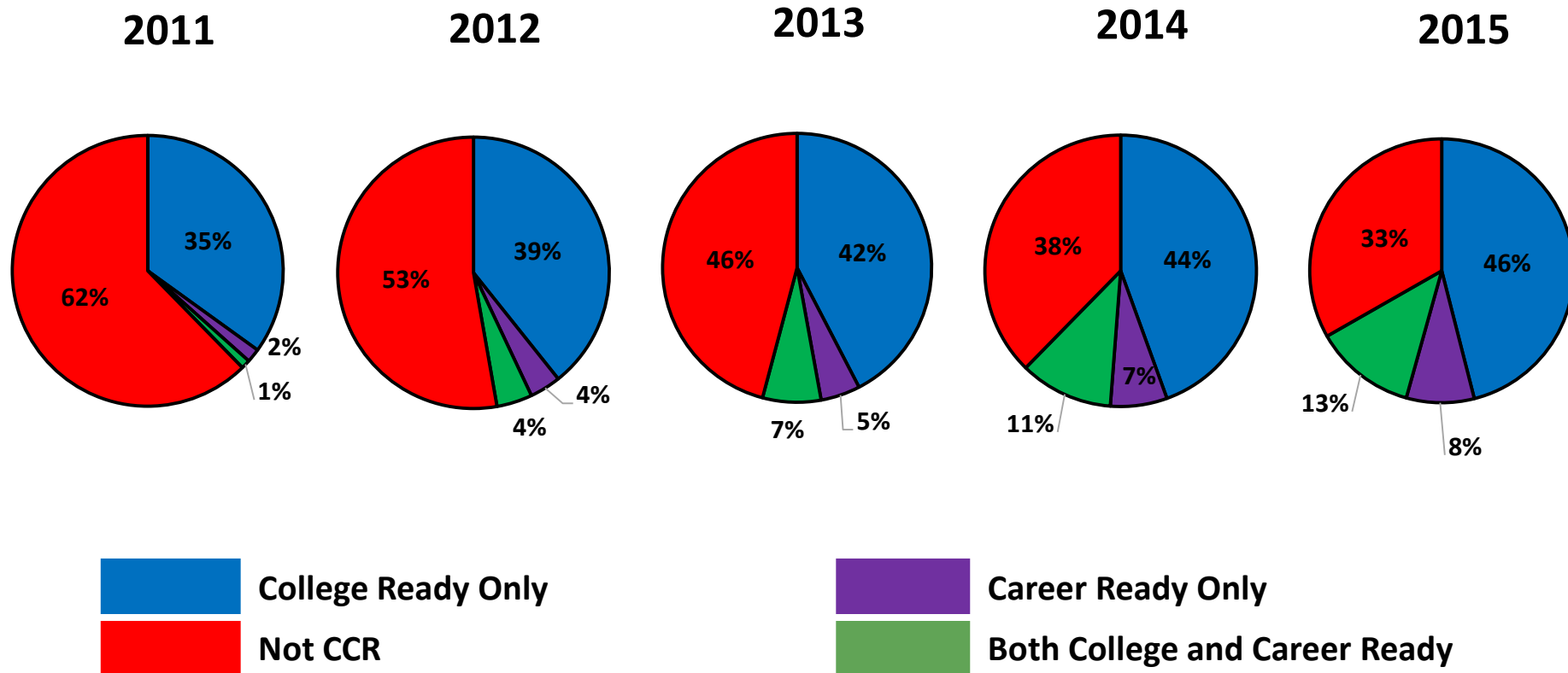


College and Career Readiness Has Increased Dramatically in the Last Five Years

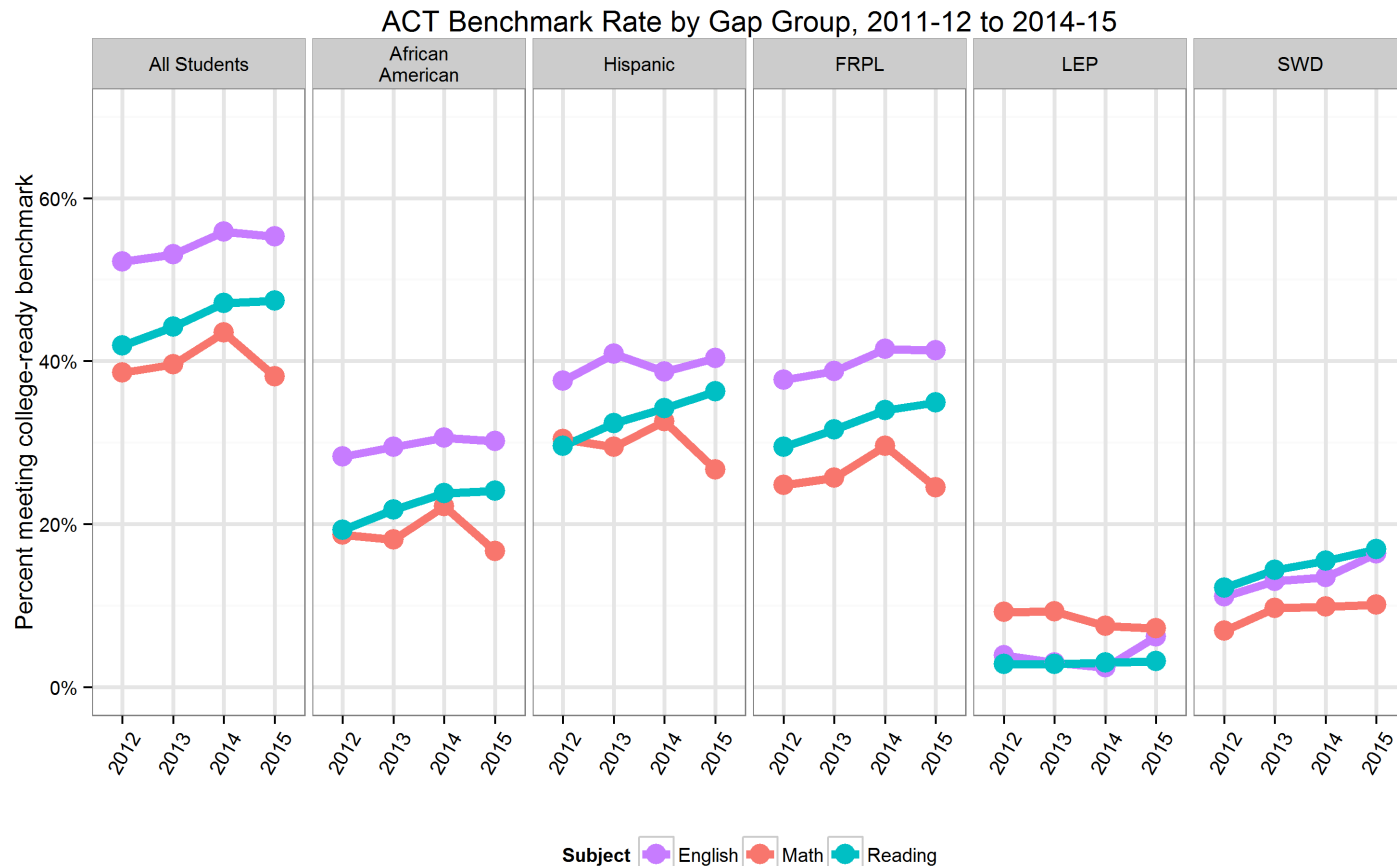

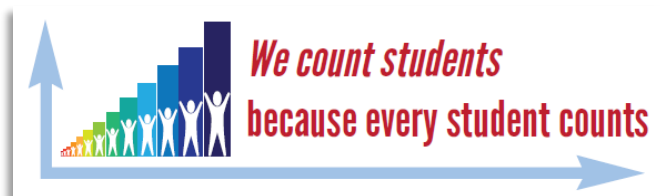
The Number of Students not College or Career Ready has Declined Significantly Since 2011

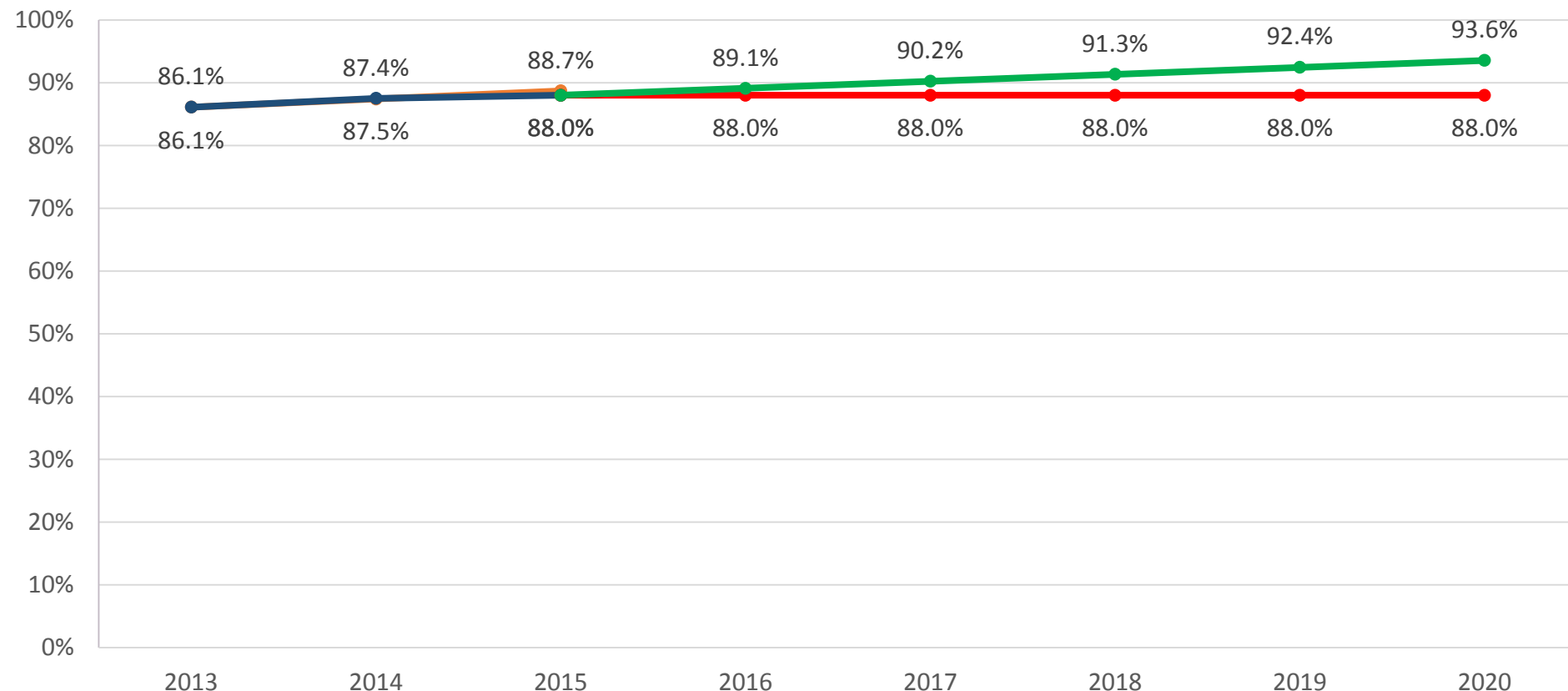

Nearly 80% of Districts Surpassed State Graduation Delivery Goal

■ 68.1% to 88.7% (N=38 Districts)

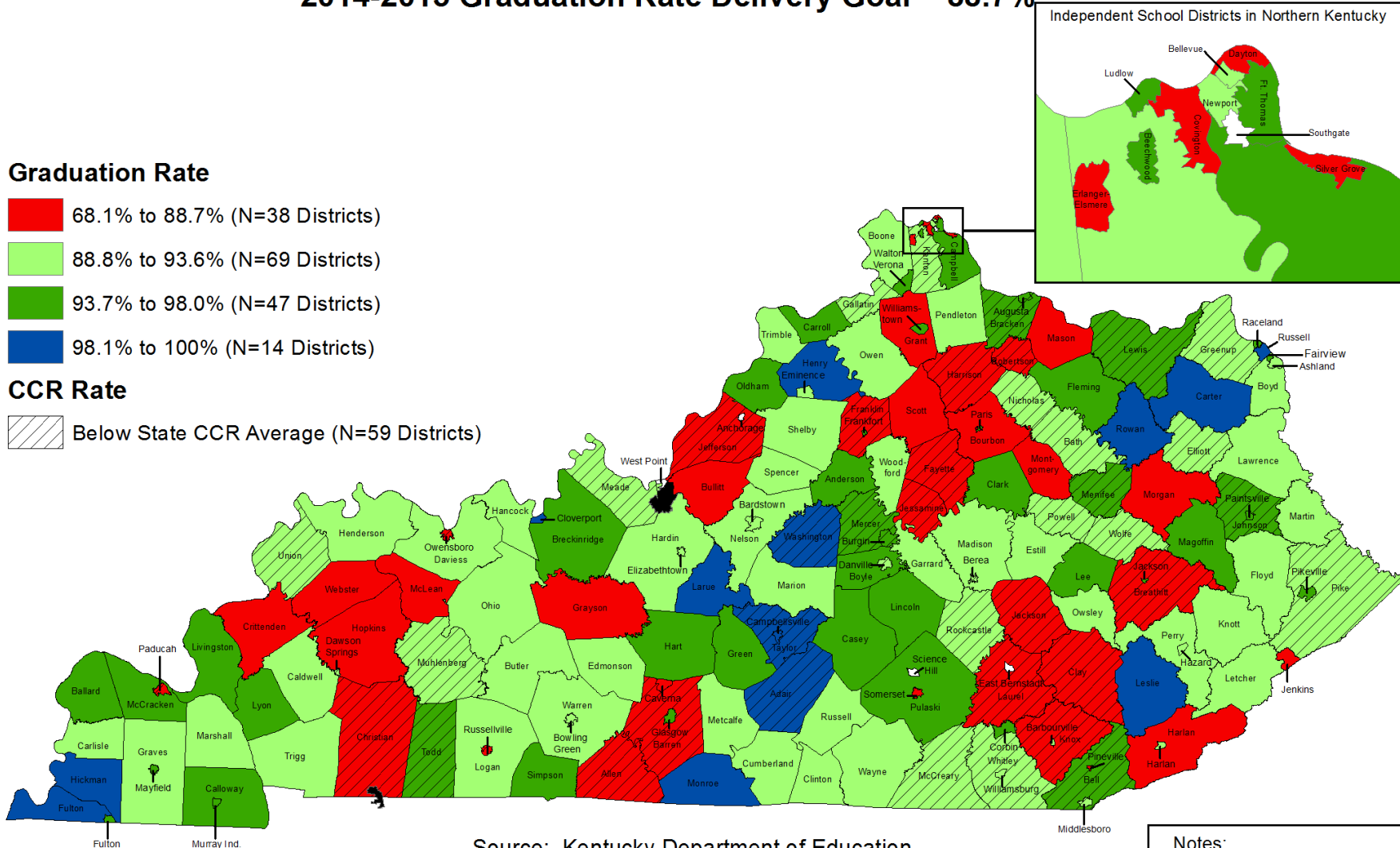
■ 88.8% to 93.6% (N=69 Districts)

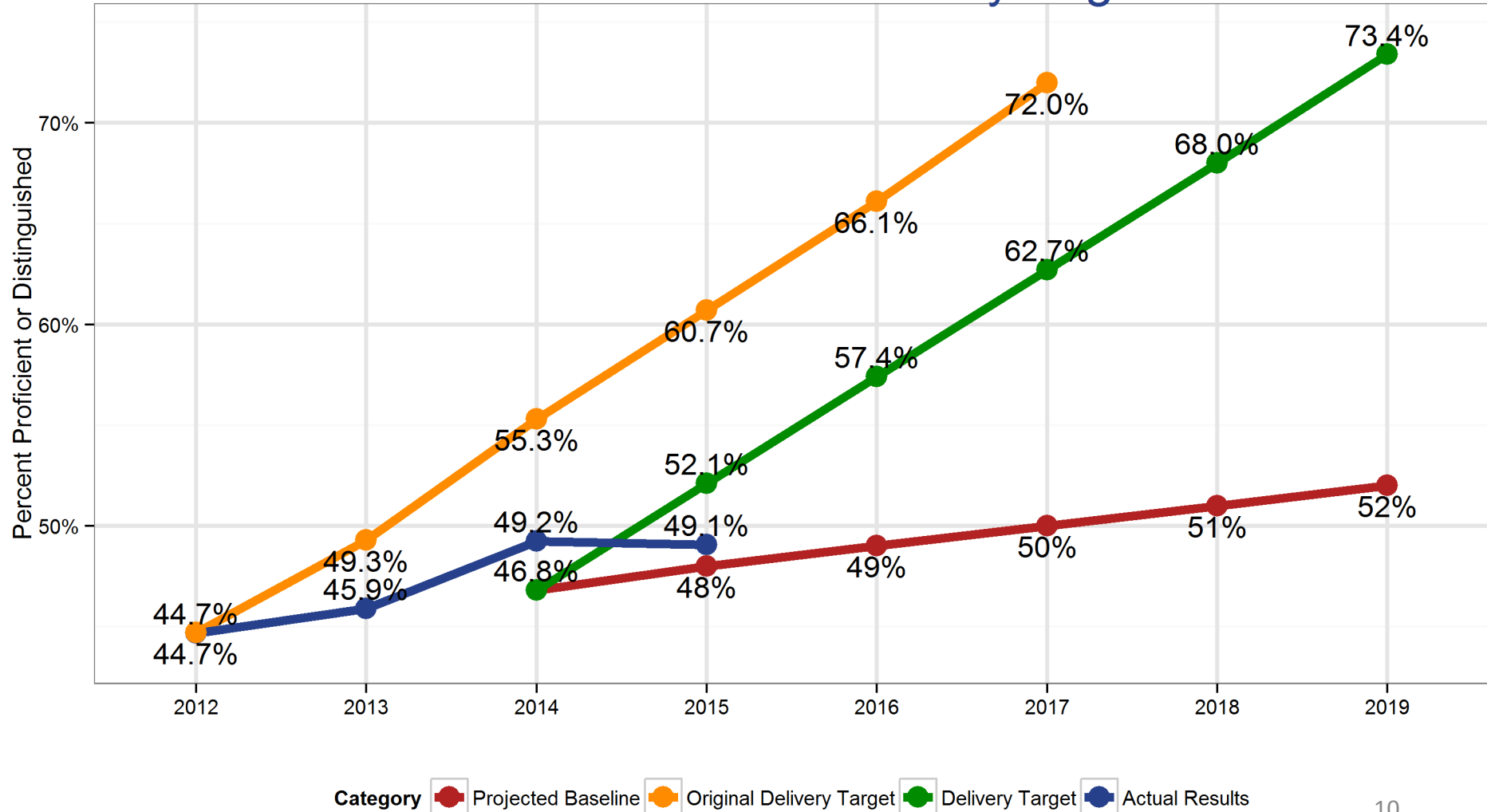

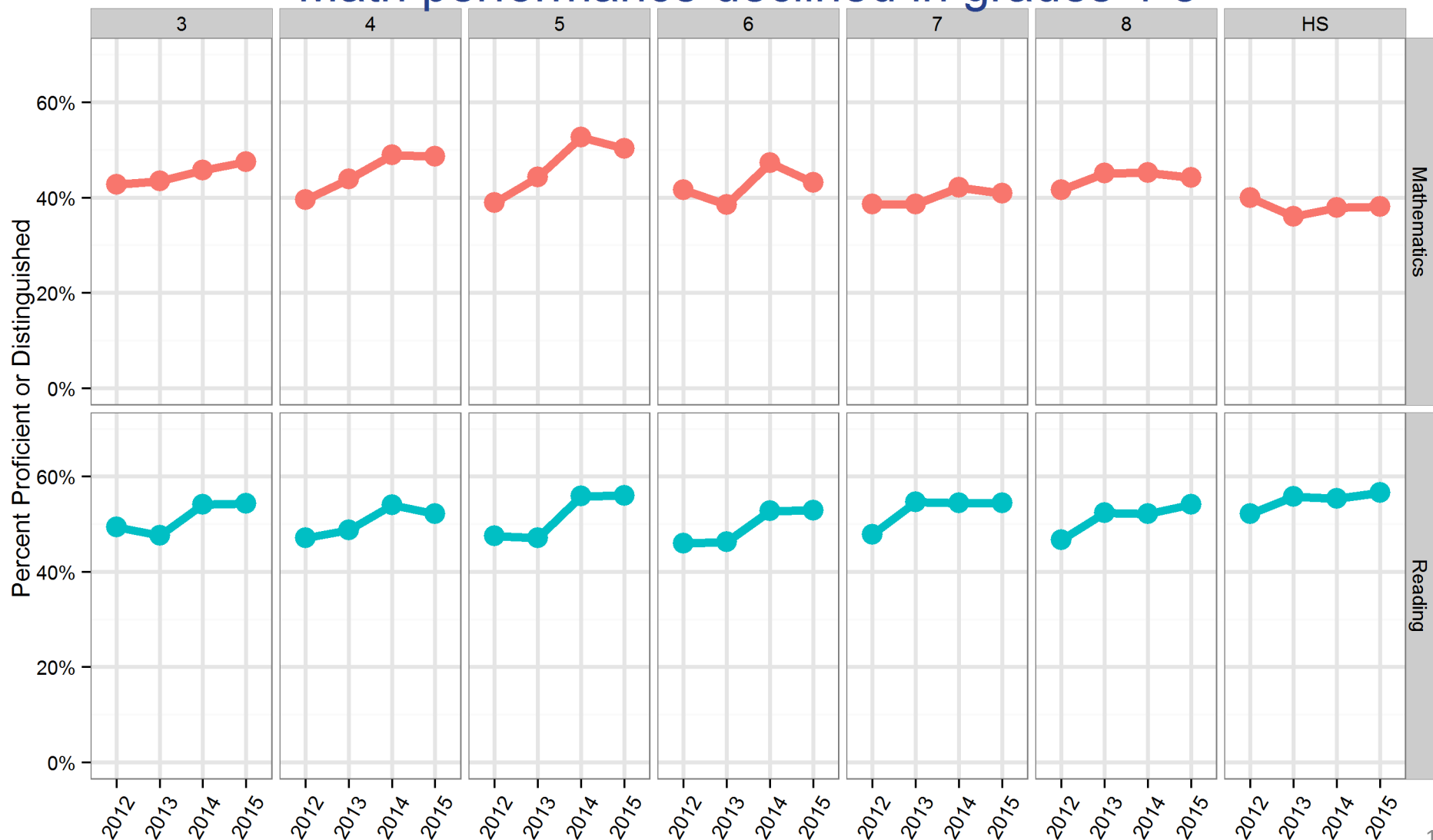

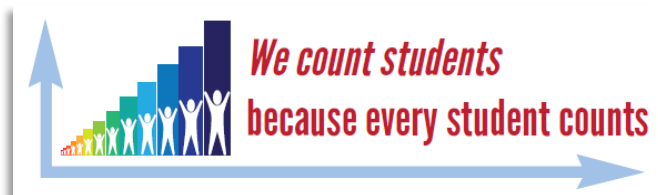
Statewide proficiency declined in 2015 and is off track to meet delivery targets



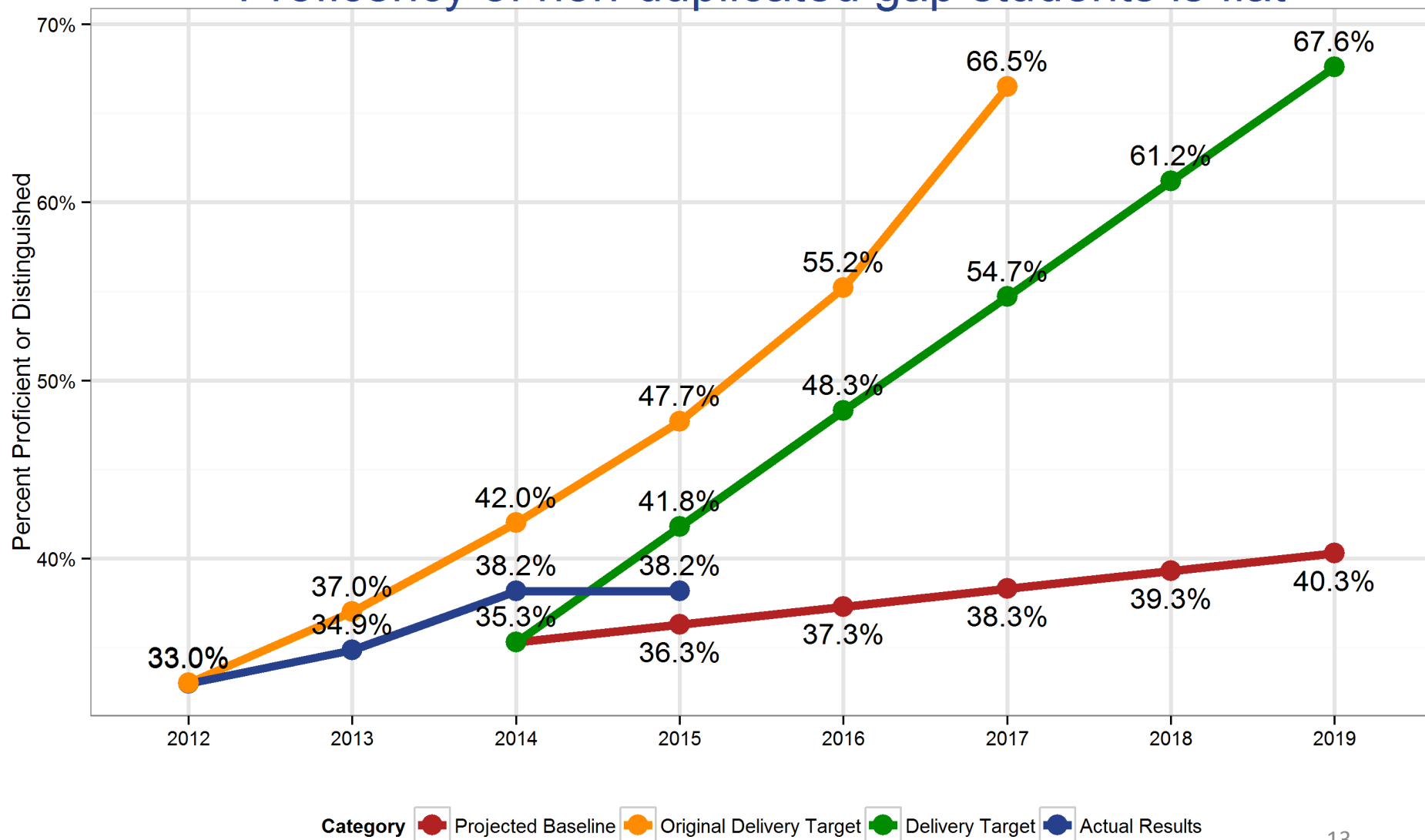
Math performance declined in grades 4-8



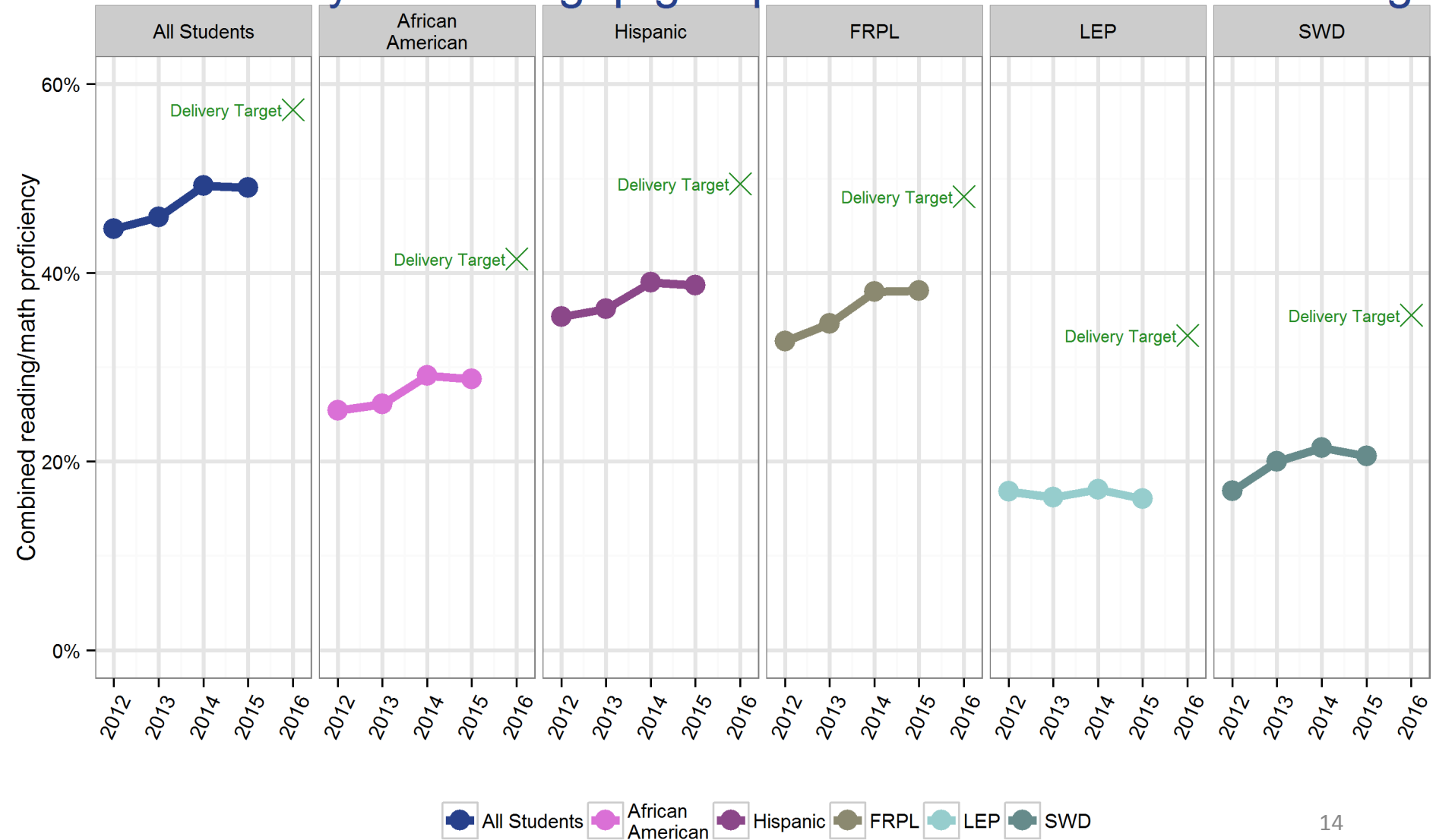

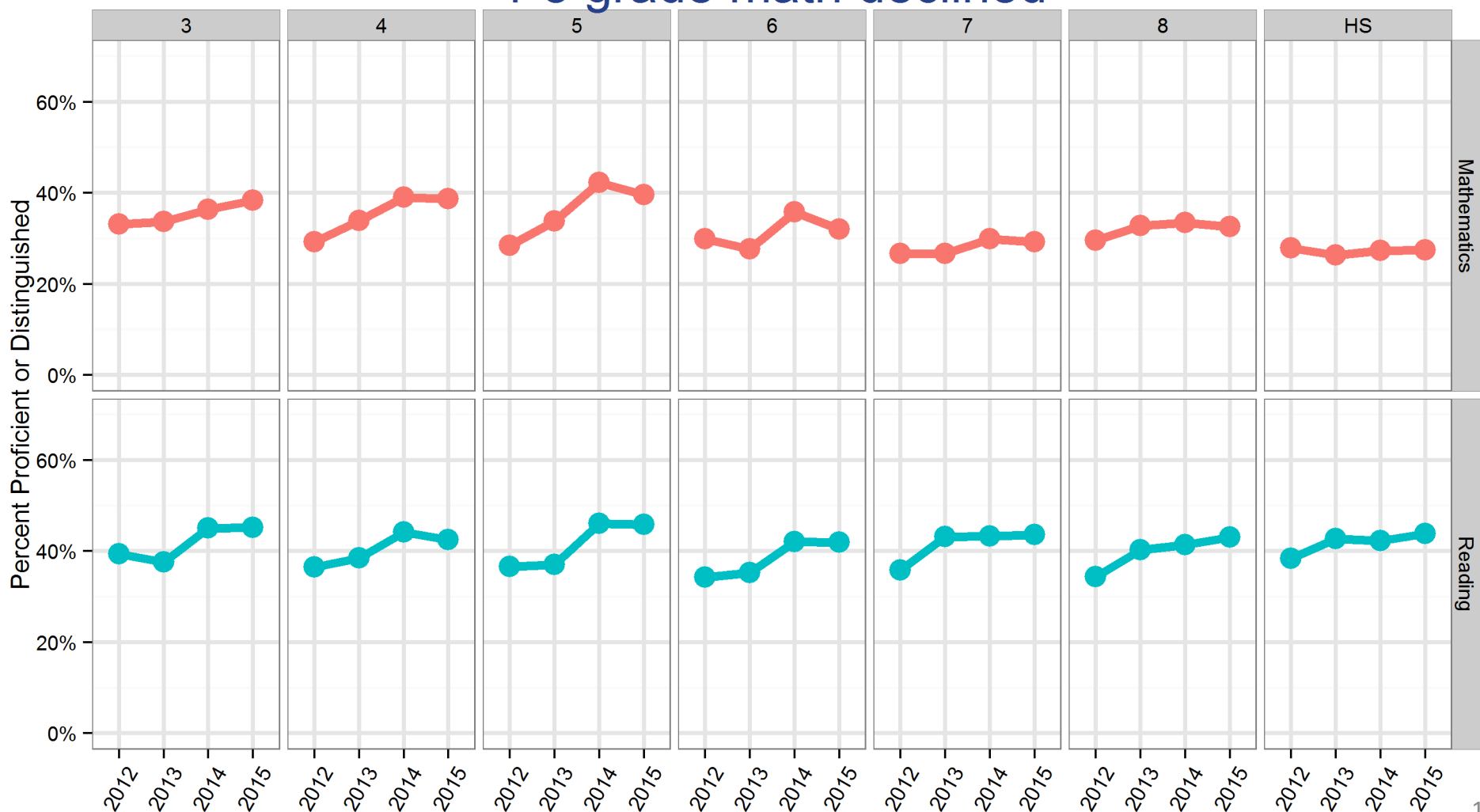
Proficiency of non-duplicated gap students is flat



Proficiency rates for gap groups are either flat or decreasing



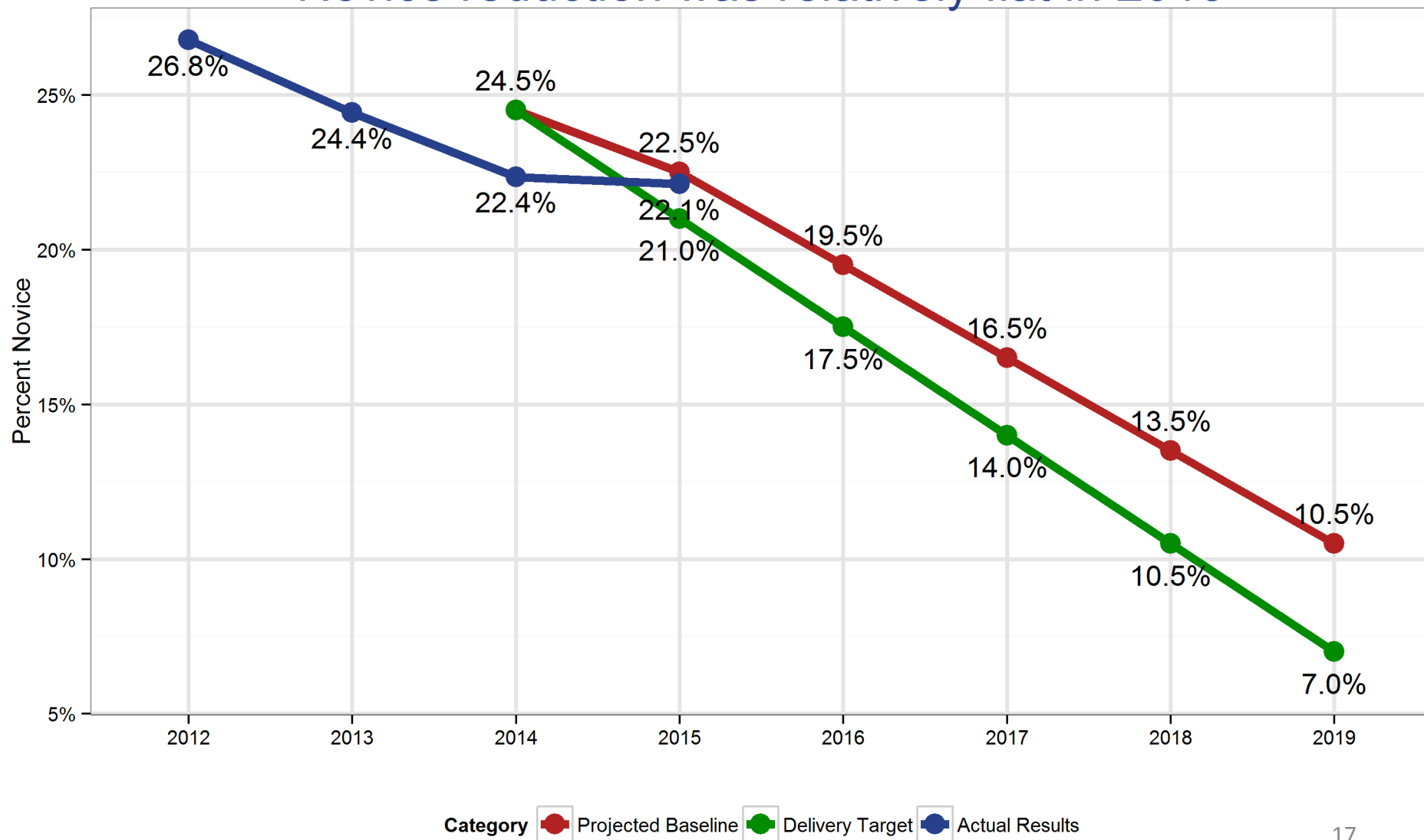
Non-duplicated gap students' proficiency was flat in reading; 4-8 grade math declined



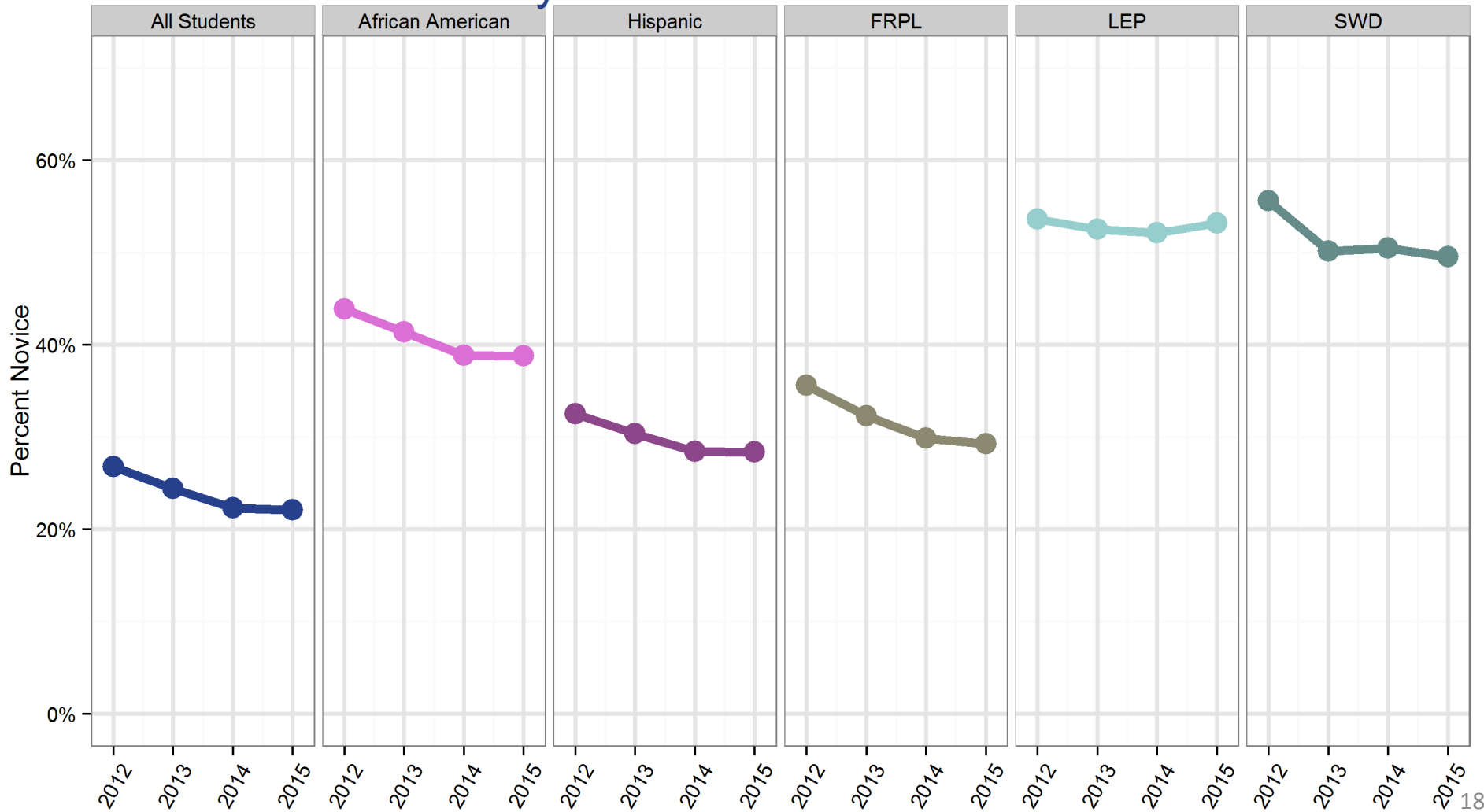
Novice Reduction



Novice reduction was relatively flat in 2015



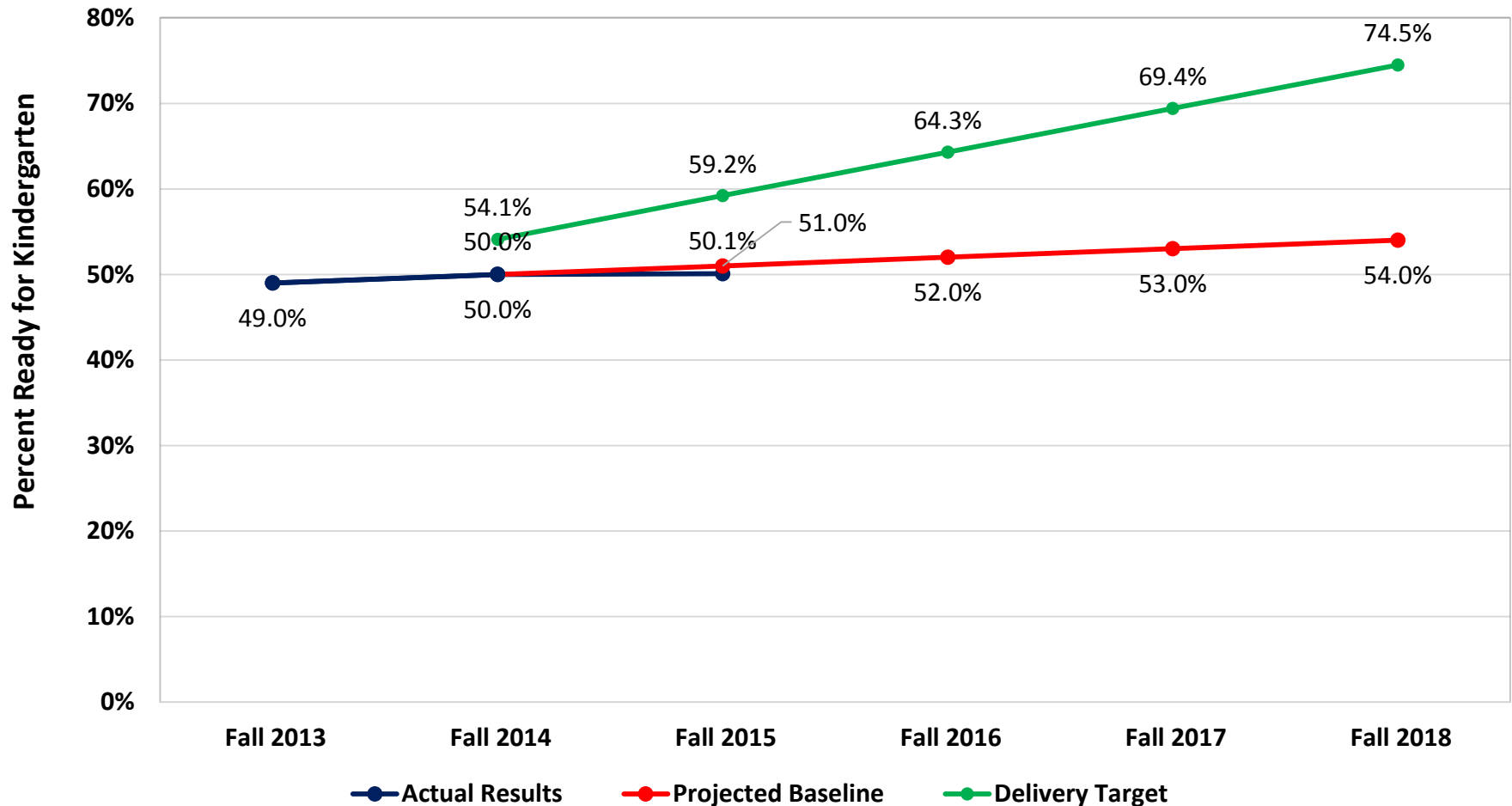
Novice rates declined slightly for most gap students, but they increased for LEP students



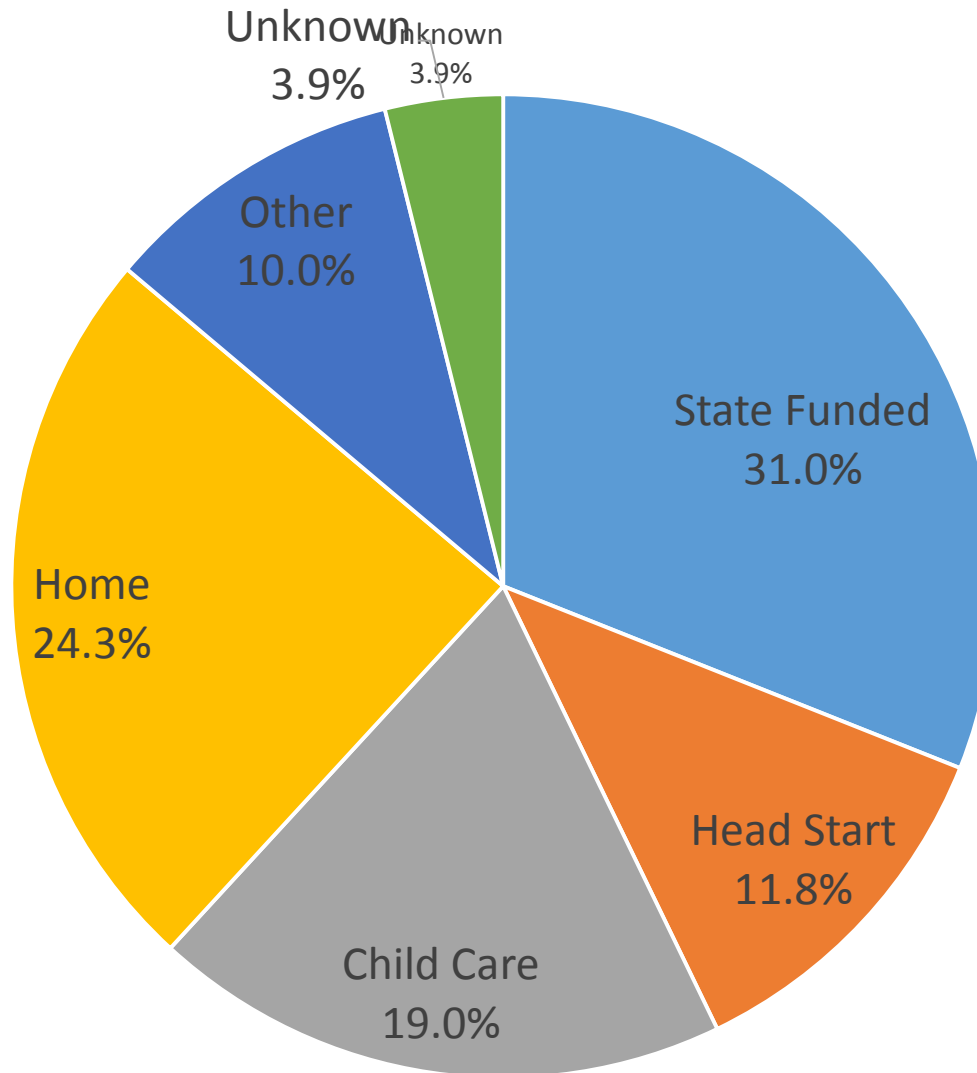
Kindergarten Readiness



Half of Preschool Students not Ready for Kindergarten

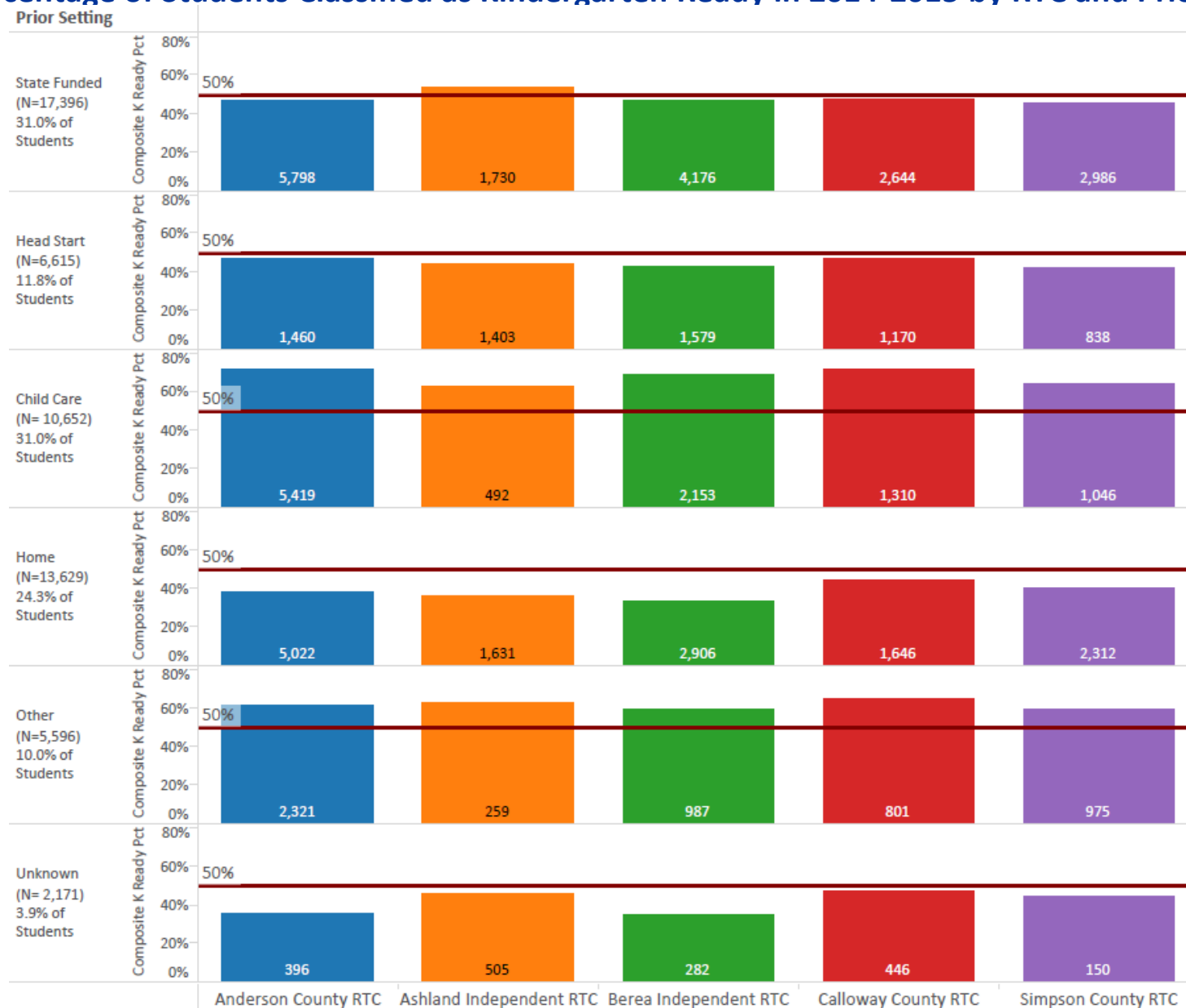


State-funded Preschool and Head Start Kindergarten Students Comprise More than 40% of all Students Taking Brigance Screener



State-funded Preschool and Head Start Kindergarten Readiness Rates Lag Behind Child-Care Readiness Rate in All Regions

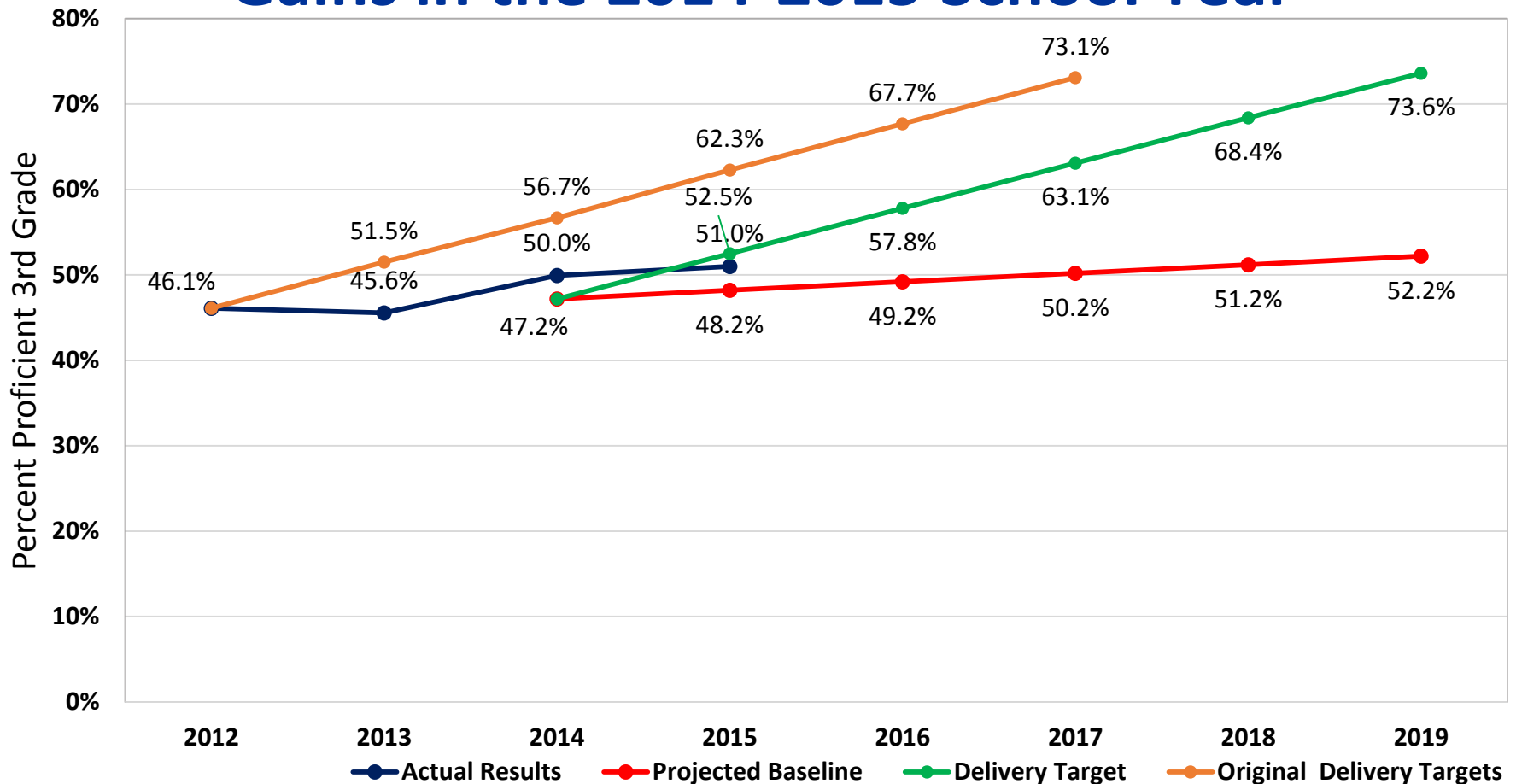
Percentage of Students Classified as Kindergarten Ready in 2014-2015 by RTC and Prior Setting



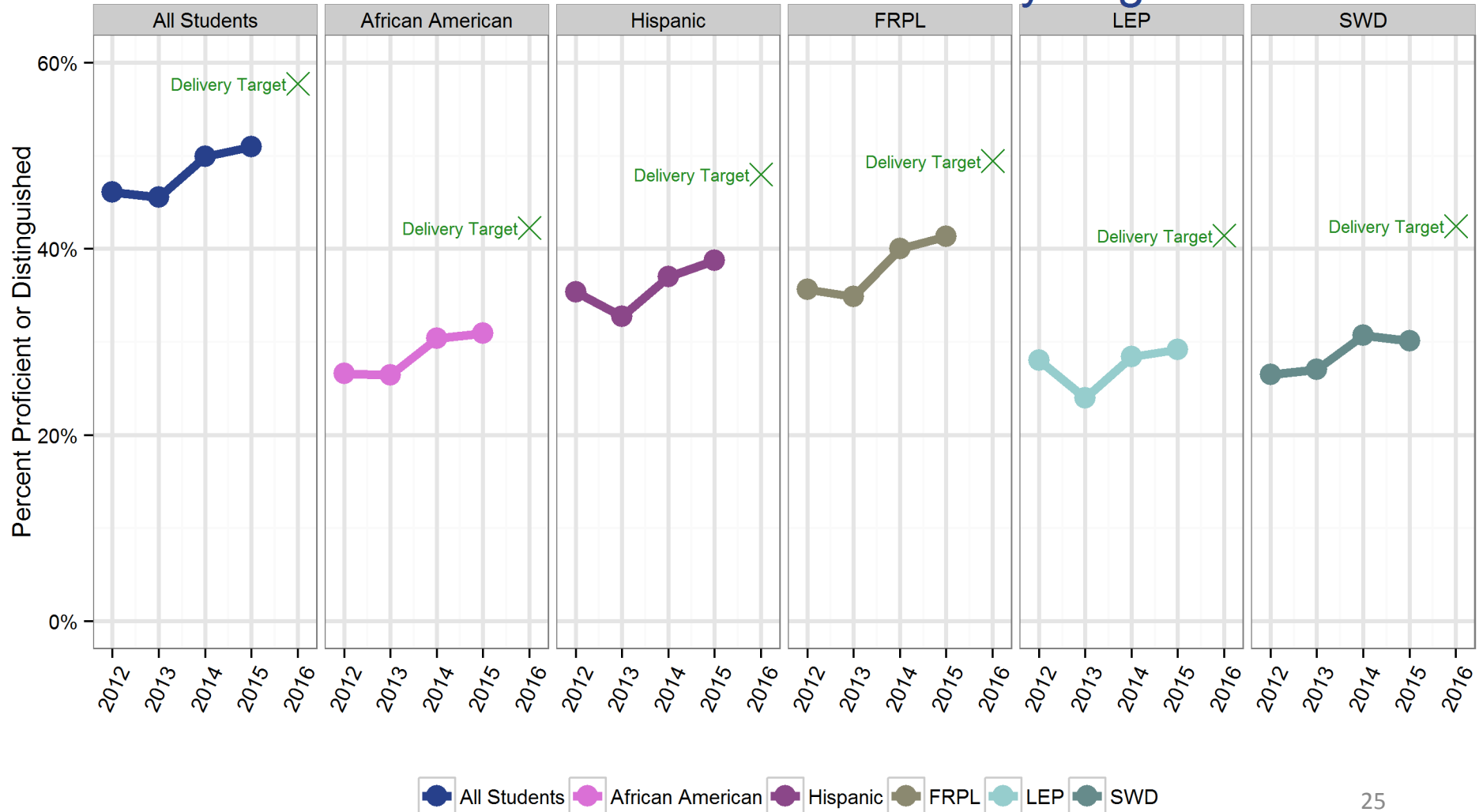
3rd Grade Proficiency



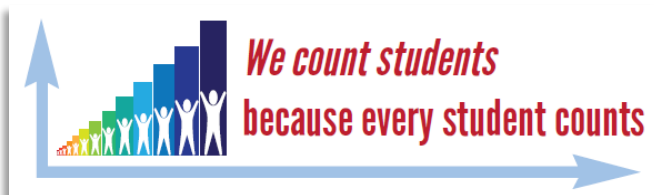
3rd Grade Proficiency Has Made Minimal Gains in the 2014-2015 School Year



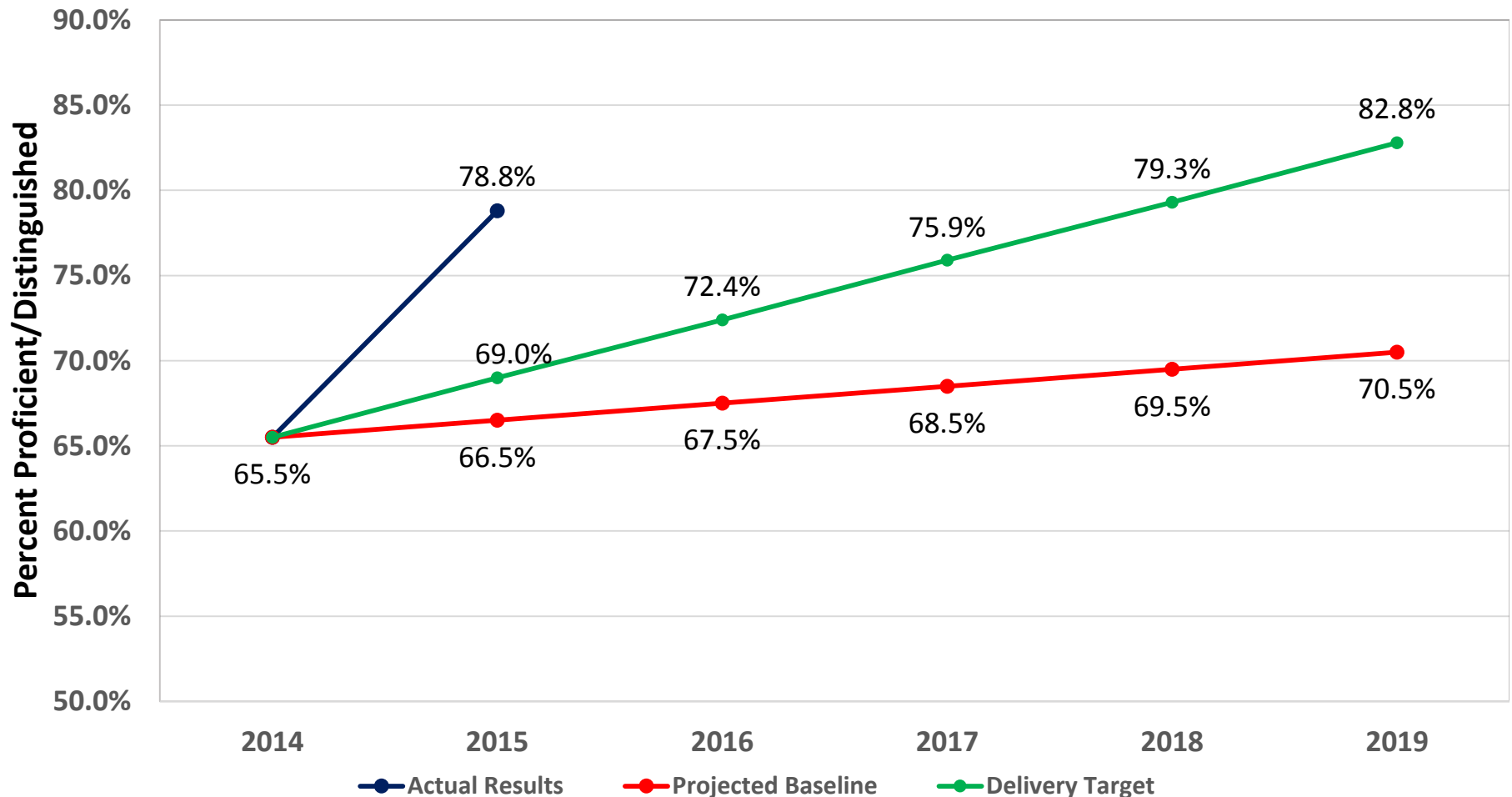
Combined 3rd grade reading/math proficiency improved, but is off track to meet delivery targets

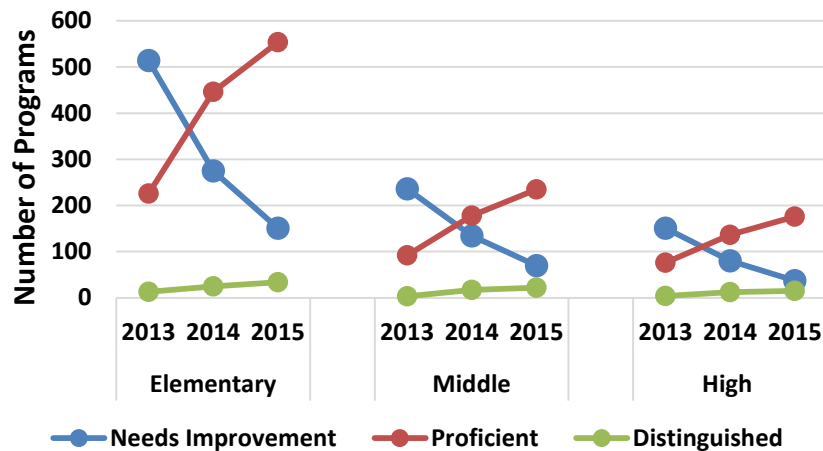


Nearly 80% of Programs Statewide are Proficient

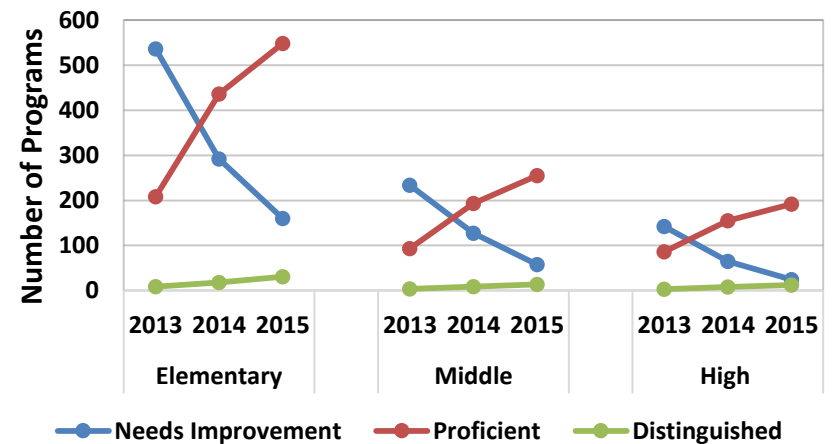


Number of Proficient Programs Increases from 2013-2015

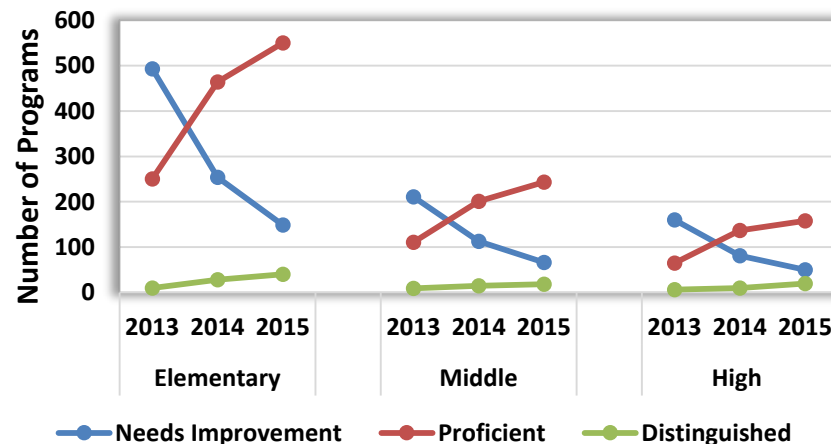
