APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED CHANGE ORDER (NO. FOURTEEN) TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE RENOVATION AT GLENDOVER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BG 12-180

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE: The renovation of the existing Glendover Elementary School is listed as priority 2c.7 on FCPS's 2009 District Facility Plan. Pearson & Peters Architects produced final Construction Documents for bidding describing a renovation of the existing building and the construction of an addition totaling approximately 73,068 SF to serve 650 students, based upon FCPS elementary school program standards. Bids were received on February 27, 2013 and construction began in June, 2013. The Department of Physical Support Services, the design consultants and the local building code officials have reviewed the progress of the work. Changes to the original plans and specifications have been necessary in order to satisfy the requirements described below. Approval of these changes allows the work to be completed.
