### Kentucky Board of Education Special Meeting August 28, 2015 Embassy Suites, 1801 Newtown Pike, Lexington, Kentucky

#### **SUMMARY MINUTES**

The Kentucky Board of Education held a special meeting on August 28, 2015, at the Embassy Suites, 1801 Newtown Pike, Lexington, Kentucky. The board conducted the following business:

#### I. Call to Order (Open Session)

Chair Roger Marcum called the meeting to order.
