SBDM Minutes
November 18, 2015

Principal Jeremy Dodd called the November 18st meeting to order at 4:00 pm in the Dayton High School Library. Members present included: Barb Lund, Bonnie Sizemore, Angie Buschle, Erin Goetz, Angela Gonzalez, and Jeremy Dodd. Others in attendance at the meeting: Scott Meyers, Rian Embry, April Brown, Lisa Klette, and Ron Kinmon.

Angie Buschle made a motion to accept the agenda. Angela Gonzalez seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Good News

- Mr. Dodd told us we are continuing to get compliments on our Duel-Credit students. He also told us there are three students that have declared early graduation. Two have met the benchmarks so far.

Committee Report

Social Studies

- April Brown told us she has 24% failure rate in the Ninth Grade. She has made home contacts and has the students coming after school for missing assignments. The number of students has dropped during the Second Quarter. Ms. Brown stated she has tried moving students, changing seats to help with problems in the classroom. She has called home for both good and bad reports. At this time she has made 31 parent calls.

Science

- Lisa Klette stated that most Middle School Failures are due to missing work. She is contacting parents and trying to get students to stay after. She has made parent contacts, but will make more. The Eighth Grade students have more failing assignments than missing work.
- David Whittington stated that class sizes are an issue with the Freshmen. Some of the classes are very large and some are small. He gives the students one chance to retake the tests and locks the tests until they prove they have studied.
- Rian Embry stated she has the highest failure rate in her teaching career. The e-mails that go out on Mondays do not tell about missing assignments. She has two days of re-teaching before she will allow them to retake the tests. She has tried explaining what they are missing, and why the answer is incorrect. If they do not come after school for help, it was discussed to assign academic detention.
- The Science teachers brought up the fact they need more money. \$1000. Will not go very far with dissecting and the need for new chemicals. Mr. Whittington told us he can't do any experiments with the chemicals that is in the lab because of their age.

Old Business

- Mr. Dodd went over Policy 08.06 discussing graduation requirements for Valedictorian and Salutatorian. This policy now states you have to attend Dayton High School for at least one full year with the Principal's discretion to be in the running for these positions. Bonnie Sizemore made a motion to accept the changes. Barb Lund seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Policy 08.03 is about the Dance and Court Stipulations. This was the second reading for this policy. Barb Lund made a motion to accept this reading. Angela Gonzalez seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- Policy 18.02 was reviewed and changes were made. This is the second reading. Bonnie Sizemore made a motion to accept the changes. Barb Lund seconded the motion. The motion carried.

New Business

- Angie Buschle wrote the new grading policy proposal that will be presented to the Board of Education at the December Meeting..
- Mr. Dodd said we need to set the dates for the SBDM meetings for the rest of the school year. We will do this at the December meeting.
- Mr. Dodd told us that February 1, 2, and 3, 2016 are the dates for the Diagnostic Review.
- We need to look at our Needs Assessment and fill out our wish list.
- Mr. Dodd said he hired an Instructional Assistant and the Board agreed to hire an additional one.
- Mr. Dodd talked about the possibility of changing the entrance of the school for next year.

Angie Buschle made a motion to extend the meeting at 5:30. Barb Lund seconded the motion. The motion carried.

- Ms. Goetz brought up the fact that the Duel Credit Juniors are taking the History of Rock and Roll and Not U.S. History. Mr. Dodd said we have no control over what Gateway teaches, but these students will cover U.S. History.

Mr. Dodd asked if we would add \$200.00 to the Postage Budget because of College and Scholarship Applications. Barb Lund made a motion to add the \$200 to Postage. Erin Goetz seconded the motion. The motion carried. Bonnie Sizemore made a motion to transfer the remaining \$702.34 from the Teacher's budget to the Surplus Budget. Bonnie Sizemore made a motion to transfer the money. Angie Buschle seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Angie Buschle made a motion to adjourn. Bonnie Sizemore seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Dodd adjourned the meeting at 5:50.
