**Objectives of Activity:** To allow Bloomfield Elementary, Cox's Creek Elementary and Bloomfield Middle School Beta members the opportunity to interact with and compete against other talented and academically excelled Beta members nationwide. Those in attendance will get to experience Beta at the national level and grow more as individuals and as leaders. Exposure at the national level will also help our students better prepare for the state convention during the 2016-2017 school year.

**Pre-trip preparatory activities:** Currently we have seven Beta members from BES, sixty four members from BMS and sixteen members from CCES who have signed up to compete in arts, crafts, talent and academics at the Kentucky Beta Convention on February 17-19, 2016. We also have a candidate running for the state office of Chaplin. We have and will continue to fundraise to help offset the cost of attending the state and national conventions. If we have any student that qualifies at the state level we request permission to travel to support those who will be competing nationally. Those who attend the national convention in 2015 were involved in their individual competitions and exhibit competitions. They were also involved in assisting other candidates from Kentucky by performing in their skits and campaigning. We will coordinate with other schools from the state of Kentucky in regards to travel arrangements and trip activities. The convention is scheduled for June 23-26, 2016. Depending on statewide travel, we may leave or return from the convention a few days prior or post the convention.

**Post-trip culminating activities:** This event takes place during summer break. Numerous photos and students personal accounts in relation to attending the convention will be collected and put together in a Beta power point. The power point will be available during the beginning of the 2016-2017 school year in an effort to increase parental and student awareness of the National Beta Club and all what it has to offer its members. Any student that wins at the state or national level can count that accomplishment as part of their Governor's Scholars Program application.
