Current initiatives of NKCEE include:

- a. The 4th annual Evidence-Based School Counseling (EBSC) conference scheduled for February 28th and 29th at the Georgia Center in Athens. We are collaborating with faculty at the University of Georgia who are also coordinating the first ever *Innovations in School Counselor Preparation* conference, February 29th and March 1st at the same location.
