BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:

A redistricting committee of parents, teachers, FCPS administrators, two school board members, a district Equity Council representative, a city planning official, a home builder and other community stakeholders started working in 2014 on a redistricting plan. On June 3rd 2015 the Board adopted the plan in anticipation of opening two new elementary schools in 2016 – 2017 and a new high school in 2017 – 2018. New elementary school attendance boundaries for Coventry Oak Elementary off Georgetown Road calls for the closure of Booker T. Washington Intermediate Academy (3 - 5) at 475 Price Road and Booker T. Washington Primary Academy (Pre-K - 2) at 707 Howard Street and the creation of a new Booker T. Washington Elementary at 707 Howard Street to serve Pre-K - 5.
