

# **FLEMING COUNTY SCHOOLS JIM HAMM, STATE ASSISTANCE MONITOR DECEMBER KDE MEETING ACTION PLAN UPDATE**

## **1. Status Update**

Fleming County Schools is focusing on three major areas at this time.

1. The district is continuing to monitor progress at the high school (a Priority School) and is meeting regularly with school leadership and teachers to ensure they provide the support the school needs to improve student achievement.
2. The district is preparing for a major renovation at Fleming County High School. The project will include a modern and up-to-date career and technical center. The district has collaborated with KDE on all aspects of the renovation.
3. The district recently began the year-long process of becoming accredited. The site visit will occur in the fall of 2016.

## **2. Action Strategies - Completion**

District leadership has met multiple times with AdvancED to prepare for accreditation.

District leadership and the KDE Education Recovery Staff continue to support the new leadership team at Fleming County High School. Not only do they monitor and evaluate the school's progress in addressing improvement priorities from the diagnostic review conducted in the spring of 2015, but they also ensure the necessary resources are provided to the school and staff to increase student achievement.

The district uses a system-wide benchmark assessment to adjust curriculum and instruction. The benchmark is well-aligned to K-PREP. School and district staff meet to disaggregate the data after each assessment.

## **3. Action Strategies - Deficiencies**

The district has not meet its goal of developing and posting school-wide learning goals aligned to Kentucky Academic Standards. District and school leadership are addressing this issue by November 20.

#### 4. Action Strategies – Additions

District leadership continues to develop its own 30/45/60-day plans to help build capacity. They also have self-assessed on addressing the improvement priorities from the diagnostic review and the Systems of Quality Standards from AdvancED.

District leadership also has received a grant to develop a district strategic plan. They participated in the first two days of training and are getting support through additional coaching.
