Regional School Programs Future Enhancement Plan

- Develop a career, technical, and vocational partnership to extend student success beyond high school.
 Goal Implementation Date: Initial Implementation-2016-2017 school year
 - February 1st, 2016 meeting to begin planning and implementation for 2016-2017 with Enzweiler Trade School in conjunction with Northern Kentucky Home Builders Association
 - Create partnerships to "fund" scholarships for students to participate in program at no out of pocket cost to the student or home district
 - Work with KDE and home districts to create a dual credit option for students participating in extension program
- Create partnerships with local agencies to enhance and extend mental health and wraparound counseling services for students.

Goal Implementation Date: TBD

- Work with local agencies to enhance mental health services already in place
- Work in collaboration with local agencies and families to increase involvement and access to community and wraparound services for students and families outside of school
- 3. Create a partnership with Northern Kentucky University (and other regional and state colleges and universities) to increase involvement in teacher education candidates and make Regional School Programs a "model school" for teacher education candidates in special education tract programs.

 Goal Implementation Date: Begin implementation in 2016-2017 school year
 - Work with pre-service teacher education candidates to provide hands on learning and teaching opportunities prior to clinical experience or first year teaching
 - Create alternative teacher and principal mentor program/roundtable group for regional discussion and increased achievement
 - Provide location for observation hours, clinical experience, mentorship, and other resources for pre-service and new teachers.
