# Changes in the process

- All requests for students to be placed in Success/Restorative Schools are now sent to Student Due Process.
  - Parents/Students/Families can walk in.
- Principals have requested that ECE families also come to Student Due Process to 'talk' with the Assistant Director of Student Due Process with hopes to improve behavior.
- This process is temporary as a new process for placing students will be designed by August 1, 2016.
- ECE placements are still under the auspices of the ECE department.

# Success Pathways Schools

## Demographics:

- Total Enrollment **increased** from 1,440 to 1,566 students
  - Enrollment at restorative schools **decreased** from 413 to 342 students
- Student demographics remain relatively **stable**, with the largest increase in % of FRL students served


	2014-15	2015-16
% Non White Students	59.2%	58.0%
% ECE	17.2%	20.5%
% LEP	2.2%	2.7%
% FRL	73.0%	79.9%

## Outcomes:

- Attendance has **decreased** from 81.3% to 76.0%
- The percentage of students suspended has **increased** from 5.1% to 13.7%
- The percentage of students scoring proficient or distinguished in **Reading** has **increased** from 15.4% (KPREP) to 22.9% (CASCADE)
- The percentage of students scoring proficient or distinguished in **Math** has **increased** from 5.6% (KPREP) to 12.5% (CASCADE)
