

Lincoln Elementary School "Home of the Little Devils" Board Report for February 24, 2016

- Literacy continues to be a point of emphasis at LES. Our students have currently read a total of 11,742 AR books compared to 7264 at this time last year. Students will now be receiving various incentives for earning certain points for the year (i.e. 25, 50, 75, 100, 150, and 200).
- The second round of Advisory Team Meetings (ATM's) were held on 1/21, 1/22, and 1/25. We are pleased with some of the growth that are students are making particularly with the research-based programs Lexia and Reading Plus.
- The final round of K-PREP Scrimmage Testing will take place on 3/21-25. Students will be answering multiple choice, short answer, and extended response questions that mimic those to be on the actual K-PREP Tests in May.
- Students continue to utilize the Math Facts in a Flash program with the goal being to master the appropriate level answering all forty questions correct in under two minutes. Twenty-one students have earned their Math Facts Master t-shirt for the 2015-2016 school year.
- The 5th grade students and teachers will be heading to Camp Joy on 2/24-26. Students have been learning about the Underground Railroad in social studies class and will now experience a simulation where they are traded off as slaves. Students will work together in teams in an effort to escape to freedom through gathering clues in the woods during the evening hours.
- Family Literacy Night is scheduled for 3/3 @6-7:30pm. Students have been working on personal writing pieces that are composed into individual and grade level published books. Students will be unveiling their books to their families and friends at the start of the program. We will also be bringing in a magician/ventriloquist to perform for everyone.
- The LES Wrestling Team competed at the state meet in Louisville, KY. Numerous student athletes placed in the top six in the state with three earning medal honors.
