A. <u>Committee Updates</u> – no reports

B. <u>Needs Assessment</u> – Mr. Duty shared a Needs Assessment document that Mr. Brewer will share at this evening's combined SBDM and Board Member Budget meeting.

## **Budget Report:**

- 1. Budget Update Current Balance -- \$4,947.40
  - All requisitions are due by May 10<sup>th</sup>.
  - Discussion was held regarding the purchasing of 58 licenses of the online reading intervention *Reading Plus*. The total cost of these year-long licenses is approximately \$3,400. A motion was made by Mrs. Berringer to pay for half of the cost of the *Reading Plus* intervention program for \$1,700. This motion was seconded by Mr. Sparks.
  - Members discussed the need to purchase more laminate for teachers. The cost of each set of cold laminate is approximately \$295. A motion was made by Mrs.
     Berringer to purchase two more sets of cold laminate at the estimated cost of \$590.
     This motion was seconded by Mrs. Stuempel.

### **New Business:**

- A. <u>Program Review Updates</u> We have a fine arts assembly being held for primary and intermediate grades on Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup>. Another program review submission is set for 2.24.16.
- B. <u>K-Prep Blueprint for 2016</u> A K-Prep document was shared with the SBDM members outlining the number of items and testing times for grades 3 6.
- C. <u>Scrimmage Testing Update</u> The third round of practice K-Prep scrimmage testing is scheduled for 3/21 25 with test reflection with students on 3/28-4/1. The SBDM teacher members explained how *GradeCam* works and how it provides students immediate feedback.
- D. <u>Learning Resources Update</u> headphones, document cameras, calculators, Renaissance Learning, etc. We are working on a needs assessment for these items and will possibly use student activity funds to purchase any additional needed items on this list.
- E. <u>Mid-Year Meetings and Evaluation Timelines</u> Mr. Duty explained the TPGES process and shared upcoming deadlines teacher observations, Student Growth Goal work, etc.
- F. <u>Parent Teacher Conferences</u> These conferences will be held on March 17<sup>th</sup>. Every LES student's family is invited to attend this conference night.

G. <u>Policy Review</u> – Consultation Policy and Instructional and Non-instructional Staff Time Assignment Policy – Mr. Duty reviewed the *Consultation Policy* with the council members. Discussion and questions were addressed regarding this policy. Revisions and additions were made for this policy with Mrs. Clayton making a motion to approve the first reading of the *Consultation Policy* and Mrs. Stuempel seconding the motion. The *Instructional and Non-instructional Staff Time Assignment Policy* was reviewed and discussed. A motion was made to reapprove this policy by Mrs. Berringer and was seconded by Mrs. Marimon.
