VI.B. School Board Member Training

Rationale:

KSBA continues to provide varied opportunities for school board members to receive training and meet their annual requirements in the mandated topics of ethics, finance and superintendent evaluation. We would like to offer one opportunity in the spring of 2016 (after spring break if possible) for board member training at NKCES.

The training fee will remain the same at \$40 for each session a participant attends to offset the cost of the trainers, travel expenses and materials. Both EILA credit and board member training credit will be available for these courses. We would like for you to identify a date, provide a space for the training that includes a projector and screen, and help promote the event to your member districts. We will handle the registration process as well as promote the training as a partnership between KSBA and NKCES. Like last year, the format for the training day will be three (3) to five (5) 60-minute workshops (depending on how many finance courses you want to include) and offer participants the option to attend only the session(s) they need and/or want. Board members need 1, 2 or 3 hours of training a year on these topics depending on how long they have served. Possible schedules for the training sessions include:

Proceeds would be distributed amongst current CO OP members. Setting up Regional School Program with separate committee. It can be done. Don Ruberg discussed options it presents for NKCES and Districts that are not currently participating in RSP. Any liability would be covered under insurance that current covers NKCES and individual districts. Way to eliminate liability to non-participating districts. Set up a new entity. Exposure removed outside of being a building owner/landlord. This route is expensive. Writing bylaws, filing articles of organization, assigning personnel, all expenses with running another entity. 2. Look at an indemnification agreement between non-participating districts and NKCES to eliminate their liability to this program. (Recommended option) The insurance coverage would have to be looked into risk with this agreement. Motion Dr. Randy Poe, and 2nd by Mike Borchers.
