Lebanon Middle School is located in a small rural community in central Kentucky. The school currently has an enrollment of 422 students in grades 6-8. Cheerleading is one sport that is available for girls and boys. This past year there were 20 participants and the same number is expected for next year. The team has previously been a non-competitive team, but this year transitioned into a competitive team to expand opportunities. Since the formation of this new team, safety equipment, particularly safety mats, have not been available. The safety of our participants is top priority and the absence of safety mats has put major limitations on our newly formed team's ability to practice the stunts that will allow us to be competitive in our region. Our team has participated in multiple fundraising projects, but these have not produced enough funds to purchase the mats. Funds have been used to pay for uniforms and to cover costs that some of our participants were unable to pay.

Items considered to be a critical component for the students to participate in the activities include:

- · Uniforms with school name, numbers, & JJWF logo. These cannot be personalized with student names.
- · Safety equipment like helmets, pads, and wrestling or cheerleading mats.
- · Balls, bats, nets, and other equipment vital to the sport.
- Reasonable storage equipment. For example, we will not fund ball carts, as mesh bags would serve an equal purpose.

Items not considered to be a critical component:

- · Video recorders, electronic timing equipment, electronic scoreboards, and most other electronic equipment.
- Warm-ups, socks, mouth guards, and other non-essential or non-reusable clothing.

- · Student duffle bags, automatic ball returns, weight room equipment, and other non-essential or non-reusable equipment.
- · Coaching fees, transportation, fields, gyms, and storage locations.
- Equipment that will be used by students in P.E. or outside of 6th 8th grades.
