
## ACCEPTING DIVERSITY PANEL DISCUSSION




# Louisville Linked Data Report

#### 24,290 JCPS students were linked to a resource 35% of these students (8,543) were linked to 2 or more resources


54,674 links were made across 153 JCPS schools/sites

#### 6th Pupil Month 2015-16




#### **Example of Basic Need Request**
