#### February/March Activities

- **Teen Parent Support** Students toured the Scholar House in Newport, KY on 2/9/16. They also participated in a Keys to Great Parenting session through the Campbell Co. Cooperative Extension Office on self-care on 2/26. During their March meeting students will learn about child development.
- **Reality Store** All 8<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students participated in the Reality Store on March 4<sup>th</sup>. Each student a monthly salary based on their GPA that they had to use to make financial choices.
- **Run/Walk Club** 7 students participated in the run/walk club, running twice weekly. They finished the club by running in the mini heart 5K on March 13.
- **Fernside** 4 Students are participating in the Fernside greif support group. They have completed 3 of the 6 sessions so far.
- **Service Learning** YSC and student council members are collaborating with Master Provisions to complete a global service project. Council members are still brainstorming to come up with project that will engage all students.
- **Mentor/Mentee Program** Senior students have been paired with identified 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students in need of some social and/or academic support. The mentor/mentee pair will work together once weekly.
- **Drug Free Club** Drug Free Club and Speech/Drama Class students will attend "To Kill a Mockingbird" at Playhouse in the Park on 3/23/16.
- **Cinderella's Closet** Referred students will be visiting Cinderella's Closet on 3/18 and 3/19.

#### **Ongoing Services**

- **Food Pantry** Dayton Youth Services Center has partnered the Free Store Food Bank to provide students and family with a food pantry. This allows students and their families to access food as needed. The pantry provides the students with the option to choose the food they prefer, and the food is easy for a student to prepare at home independently.
- Counseling –Kristie Barrow (Lifepoint Solutions therapist) and Christine Luttreell (NorthKey Community Care therapist) counsel students referred by the YSC coordinator. The therapists have no openings at this time.

## **Upcoming** Activities

- Career Day YSC is working to recruit local professionals for the DHS career day.
