STAFF NOTE

Review Item:

780 KAR 7:060, Equipment Inventory (First Reading) (Amendment to existing regulation)

Commissioner's Recommendation:

At the April meeting, the Commissioner recommend approval of the proposed amendments to 780 KAR 7:060. No action is required at this meeting.

Rationale:

As a result of the Commissioner's request for the review of all regulations pertaining to career and technical education, the Kentucky Board of Education will be asked to approve the proposed amendments as the amendments simplify the regulatory scheme and update policy and language within Title 780.

Applicable Statute or Regulation:

KRS 45.301(1)(f), 45.313, 56.070-185, 156.802(3), 156.852

History/Background:

Existing Policy: KRS 45.301(1)(f) gives the Finance and Administration Cabinet supervision of purchasing and storekeeping and control of property and stores. KRS 45.313 mandates that each budget unit shall maintain a current inventory of equipment having an original cost of 500 or more. KRS 156.802(3) gives the Department of Education's Office of Career and Technical Education the responsibility for all administrative functions of the state in relation to the management, control, and operation of state-operated secondary area technology centers. KRS 156.852 gives the Kentucky Board of Education the authorization to carry out the purposes of the the program of career and technical education. Title 780 provides administrative regulations for the state-operated area technology centers, also known as the Kentucky Tech System.

Summary: Since the merger of Kentucky's two secondary career and technical education (CTE) systems in 2013 through HB 207, the Office of Career and Technical Education has worked to identify statutes and administrative regulations that could be amended or repealed in an effort to provide clarity and simplify the regulatory scheme. The proposed changes to this regulation will amend the title, incorporate language from 780 KAR 7:070, which is being repealed in a separate staff note, and revise outdated terminology.

Amending the title will broaden the scope of the regulation to include equipment insurance operating procedures, which was previously included in 780 KAR 7:070.

Budget Impact: The proposed amendments to this administrative regulation have no fiscal impact on the Kentucky Department of Education.

- responsible for the management and control of an inventory system for <u>career and</u> [vocational-]

- funds shall be maintained on this inventory and identified in accordance with 200 KAR 5:021.

- 11 (3) Equipment on loan from industry requiring insurance shall be insured under the Inland
- Marine policy underwritten by the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
