## MORGAN COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT DISTRCT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT\*

A public hearing was held at the Morgan County Board of Education on December 30, 2015, at 5:30 PM. The purpose of the public hearing was to propose an amended District Facility Plan developed by the Morgan County Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 11-0 in favor of the proposed amended plan and the Board voted 4-0 to approve the amended plan.

There was three individual(s) in attendance. Marshall Jenkins, Morgan County Board Chair, served as the locally-appointed hearing officer. Superintendent Barnett, Michelle Vance, and Darren Sparkman were present.

#### COMMENTS

The hearing officer called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. It was explained that those persons wishing to speak would be given the opportunity and that written statements would be accepted. All considerations will be made available to the Kentucky Board of Education via the hearing officer's report. The district facility director read the proposed amended District Facility Plan which includes:

- 1. Switching the current high school from permanent to transitional.
- 2. Amend the current student projections to 598.
- 3. Amend the current New Morgan County High School from renovation to a new facility as per recommended by KDE.
- 4. Amend the facility plan with the addition of demolition of the existing high school
- 5. Amend the facility plan with the addition of new entrance road and bridge
- 6. Amend the plan for site acquisition
- 7. Amend the total estimated cost for the new facility to 27,746,596.

The floor was opened to those who wished to make a statement and no one wished to comment on the amended facility plan. There was also no written statements to be read.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the amended District Facility Plan developed by the Morgan County Planning Committee and adopted by the Morgan County Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Morgan County School District. A copy of the amended plan is attached.
