Review Item:

702 KAR 7:065, Designation of Agent to Manage Middle and High School Interscholastic Athletics and Revisions in Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA) Bylaws (First Reading) (*Amendment to existing regulation*)

Commissioner's Recommendations:

At the April meeting, the Commissioner will ask for approval of 702 KAR 7:065 and the changes to the bylaws. No action is required at this meeting.

Rationale:

The amendments have been approved by the KHSAA Board of Control and the Delegate Assembly.

Applicable Statute or Regulation:

KRS 156.070 702 KAR 7:065 KHSAA Bylaws

History/Background:

Existing Policy. 702 KAR 7:065 (included as attachment "A") designates the KHSAA as the entity to manage middle and high school interscholastic athletics. This regulation also requires that the Association conduct a biennial review of its Constitution and Bylaws at both the high school and middle school level, and such was done during the 2014-2015 school years by the KHSAA Board of Control.

Summary: The proposed changes to the high school regulations that received the requisite 2/3 vote (included as attachment "B") reflect items that were presented to the membership of the Association at its September 10, 2015, Annual Meeting of high schools. Items considered at this Annual Meeting are submitted both by the Board of Control as part of its annual Constitution and Bylaws review, and by the member high schools, and are reviewed by the Board of Control prior to the development of the final agenda. At the 2015 Annual Meeting of the member high schools, 202 schools were present; therefore, all proposals required 135 affirmative votes for passage. In accordance with the KHSAA Constitution and Policies and Procedures as well as the requirements of 702 KAR 7:065, any amendment receiving the requisite vote of the membership is to be considered by the Board of Control and a recommendation made to the Kentucky Board of Education for further action.

In accordance with these procedures, the following amendments to the KHSAA Bylaws for its high school members were approved by the listed votes. These amendments will be considered by the Local Superintendents Advisory Council at its meeting in January 2016, and have been considered by the Board of Control (BOC) of the KHSAA for implementation during the 2016-17 school year unless otherwise noted. The proposals received the requisite vote of the Board of Control.
