The grant request to the Owensboro Health Foundation is for the purpose of implementing the TEEN Certification for Emergency Response Team (CERT) program. The program will train students to serve as emergency responders in the event of a disaster.

Grant funds will provide the backpacks containing emergency response supplies that the CERT trained students will receive as part of their training. The backpacks, with the needed supplies, will cost an average of \$80.00 each. Other items to be purchased through the grant will be one-time purchased of long metal rods to be used for training in lifting heavy items and wood for the construction of a wall needed for training.

What components/work/salary/materials will the grant not pay for that will be necessary for the district to incur? Be specific.

The grant will provide the first year's expenses for implementing the program.

The TEEN CERT program, implemented through the nursing class, will rely on students providing their own backpack after year one. The nursing staff will solicit medical partners for help in providing the first aid supplies to help provide these to the trained CERT students for their future use.
