Recommendation/Motion: Approve the requested shortened school day for these students as presented.

**Background/Rationale:** A shortened school day is being requested for a student with a disability. This request represents the recommendation of a 504 Committee based on data from the current Individual Accommodation Plan and a physician's recommendation. A plan has been developed to address the student's return to a full school day. The 504 Committee will continue to address this possibility with input from the physician.

## **PROPOSAL**:

- 1. A student with 69 absences and a diagnoses of ADHD and Crohn's Disease is experiencing pain and fatigue with medication and treatments.
- 2. A 4<sup>th</sup> grade who has never been exposed to school with a diagnosis of cerebral palsy will need a gradual transition due to physical endurance.
- 3. A double amputee will require a shorten day to adjust to Kindergarten and new prosthetic legs.
- 4. A student returning from a treatment setting and diagnosed with disruptive mood dysregulation and PTSD will require a shorten day due to recent behavioral struggles.

5. A previous homebound student dealing with panic disorder, OCD, and depression will need a shorten day to ease back into the school setting and avoid mental health regression.
